Texas Workforce Solutions Vocational Rehabilitation Services Transferring to Workforce Solutions Office in Corsicana

Two vocational rehabilitation services counselors from the Texas Workforce Solutions – Vocational Rehabilitation Services office in Corsicana will be the first to officially move into co-located space at Workforce Solutions offices as part of the transition of services from the former Department of Assistive and Rehabilitative Services (DARS) to the Texas Workforce Commission (TWC). These team members will integrate vocational rehabilitation services with workforce development and employment services provided by Workforce Solutions North Central Texas area.

Co-location of VR staff within local workforce centers, known as Workforce Solutions offices, around the state, will allow for shared resources and will benefit VR customers through the expanded network of employment connections and will benefit employment services staff through on-site expertise to assist job seekers with disabilities. The movement of Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) staff is occurring as required by Texas SB 208 passed in 2015 that merged several former DARS programs with the TWC on September 1, 2016.

The transfer of these programs occurred with no disruption of service to VR customers and there will be no disruption to services related to these VR staff movements.

The legislation mandated that VR staff be co-located with staff from Workforce Solutions who provide workforce services. These moves will occur over the next several years as current field office leases expire or can be renegotiated, and as Workforce Solutions office space is available and ready to accommodate the relocating staff and services.
