- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 19.2% in Ellis County, TX from 58,105 to 69,265. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 15.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.5% to 64.8% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.1% of Ellis County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.7% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Warehousing and Storage.




Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Ellis County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.34%, increasing from 3.34% 5 years before.






Veterans

Ellis County, TX has 10,774 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 10,645.




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is about average in Ellis County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 82,477 racially diverse people, while there are 90,495 here.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration






