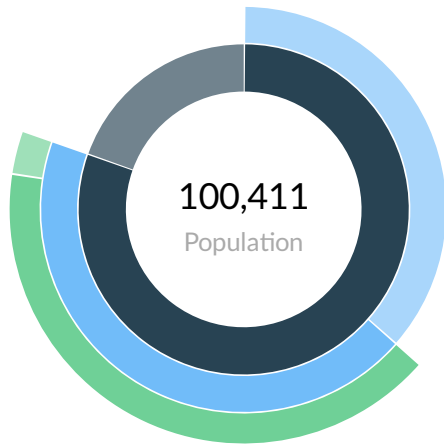
Median household income is **\$8.4K below** the national median household income of \$60.3K.

- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 1.7%** in Hunt County, TX from 32,970 to **32,410**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 3.1% by 4.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 54.7% to 54.7% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Hunt County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.9% below the national average), and **7.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (State Government).

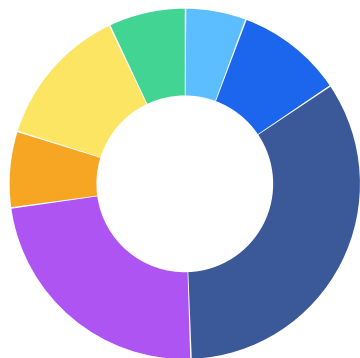

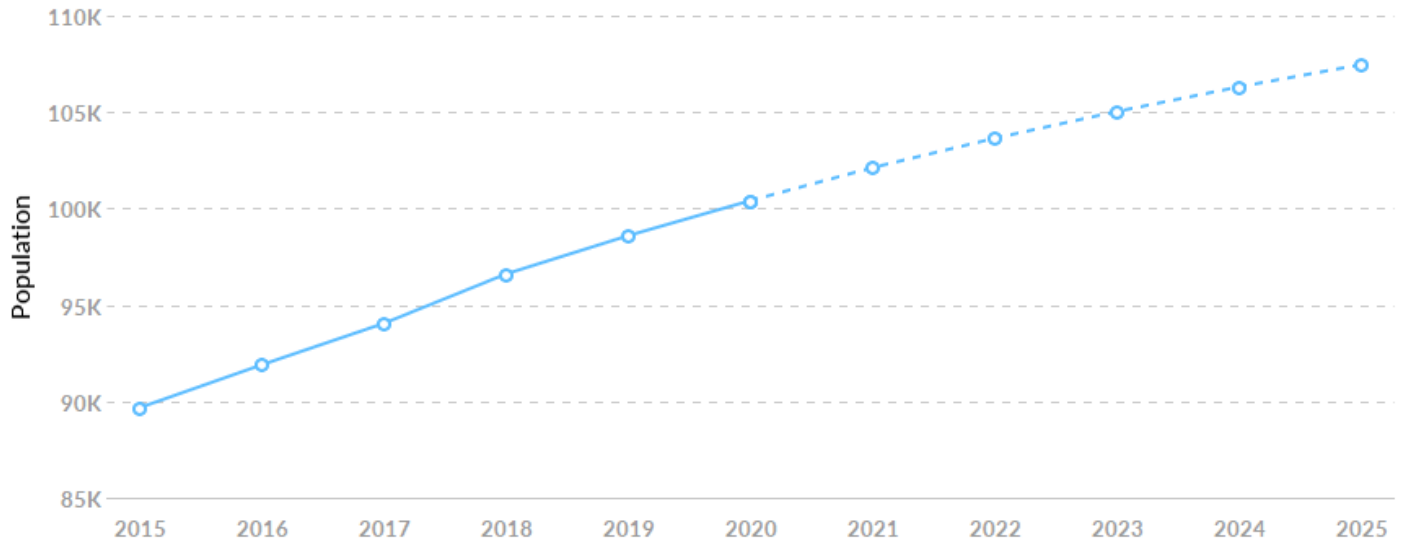

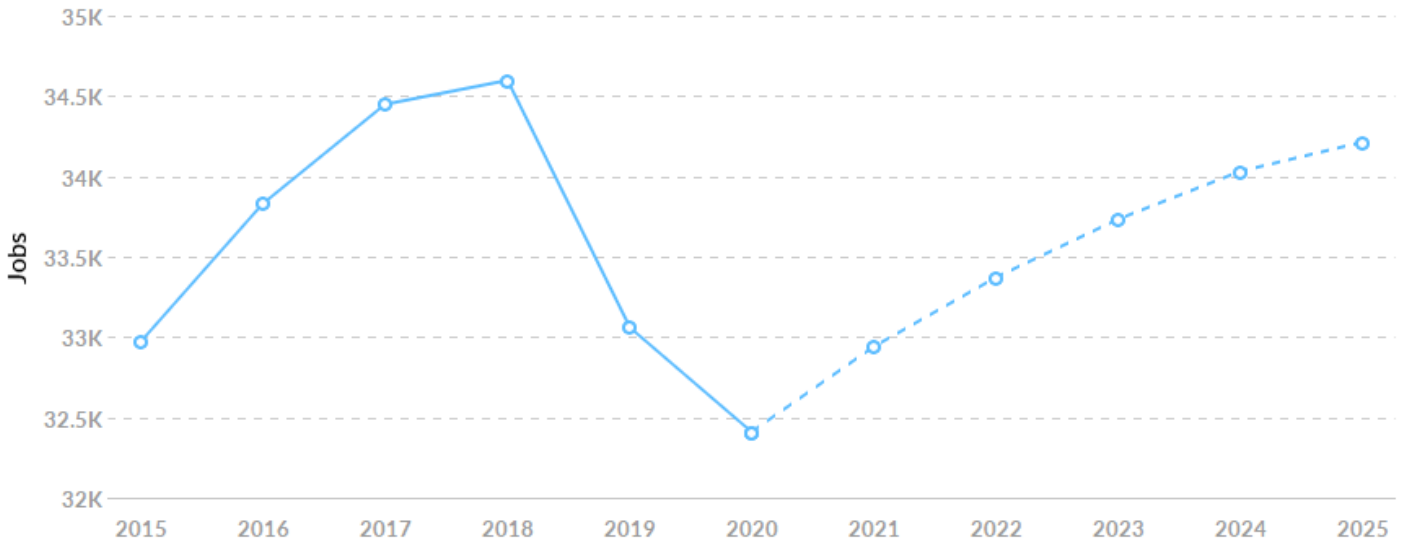

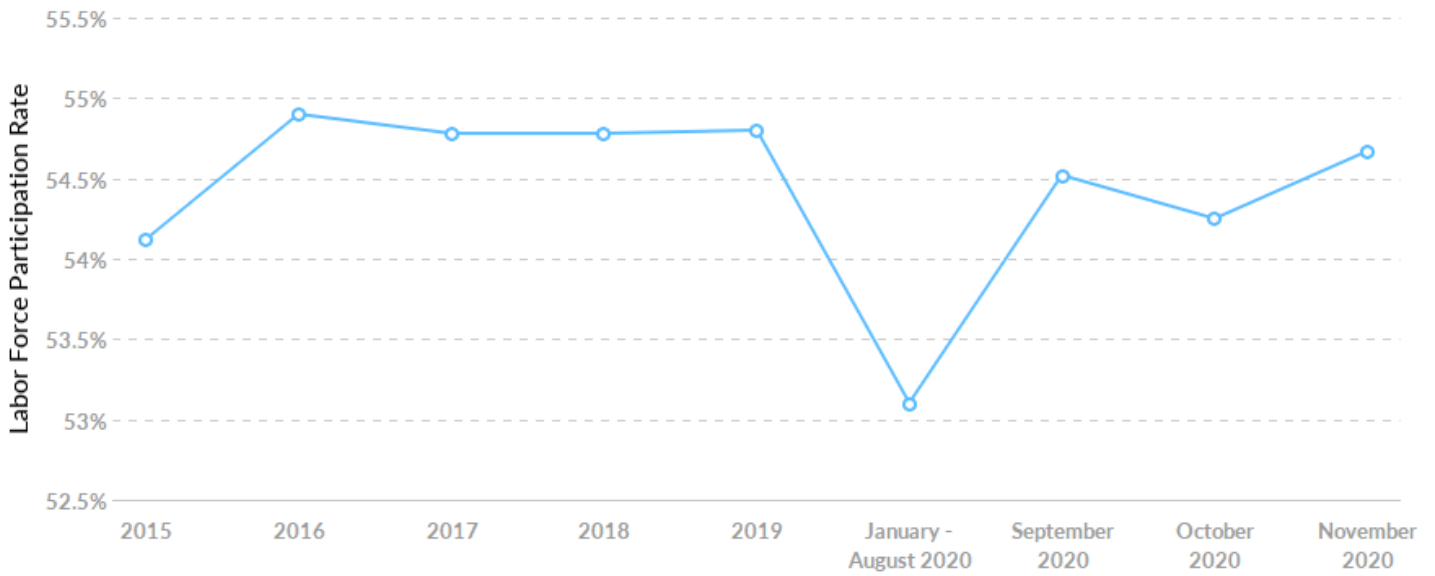
Job Trends

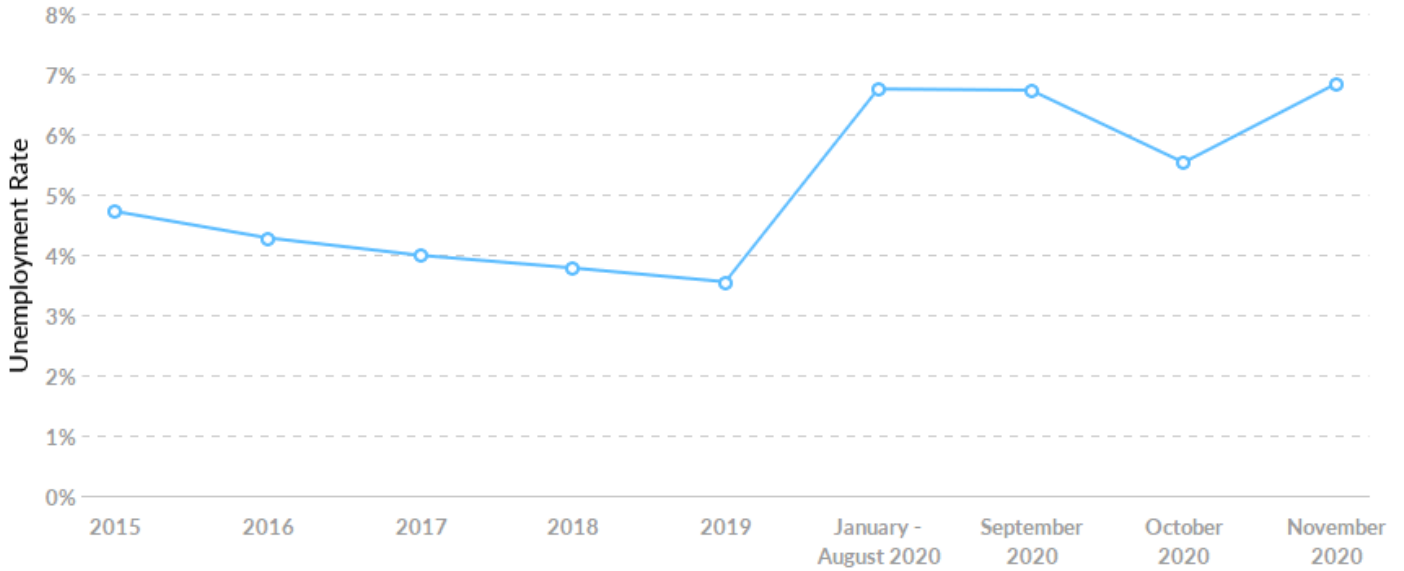

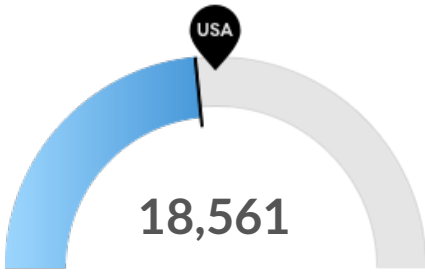
Unemployment Rate Trends

Hunt County, TX had a November 2020 unemployment rate of 6.84%, increasing from 4.72% 5 years before.



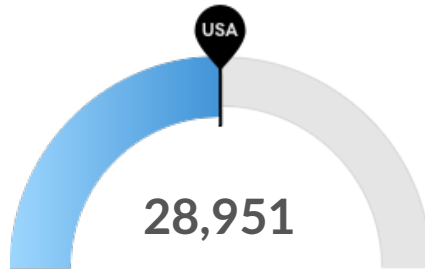

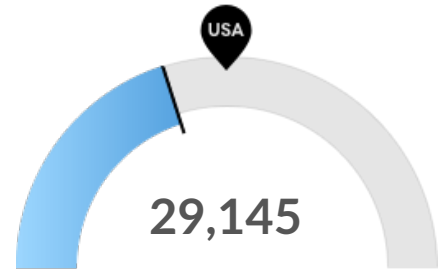
Millennials

Hunt County, TX has 18,561 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 20,329.



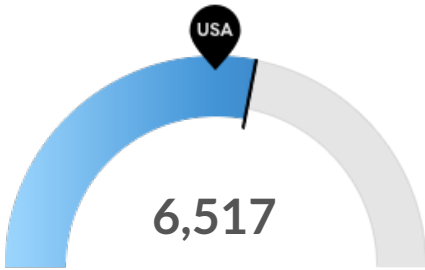
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Hunt County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 28,988 people 55 or older, while there are 28,951 here.



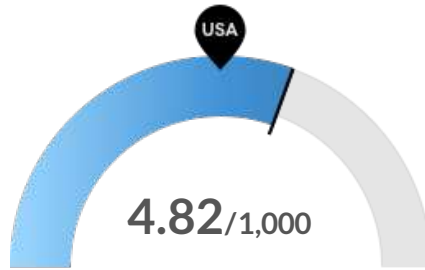
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Hunt County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 39,328 racially diverse people, while there are 29,145 here.



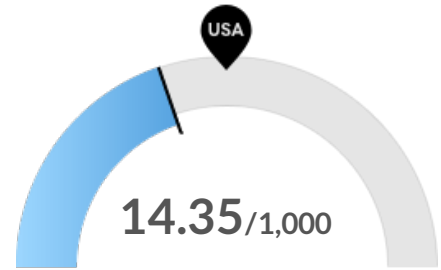
Veterans

Hunt County, TX has 4.82 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.53 per 1,000 people.

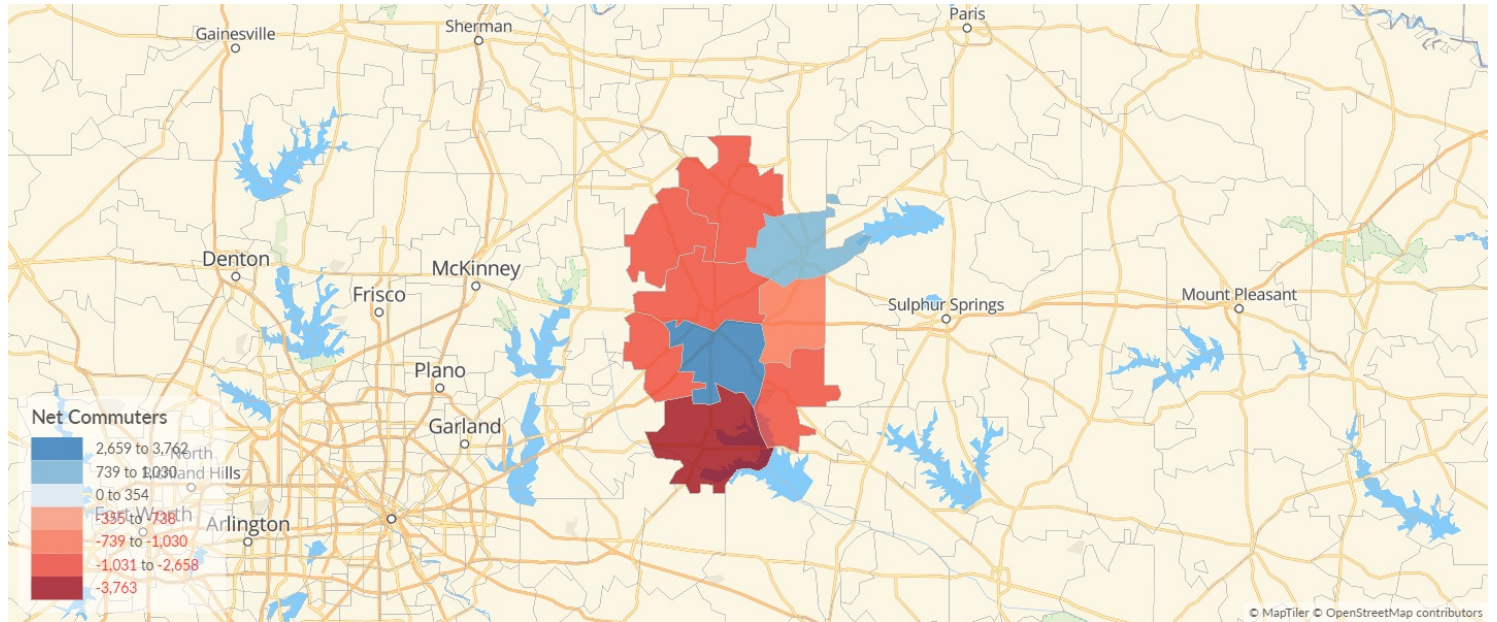


Property Crime

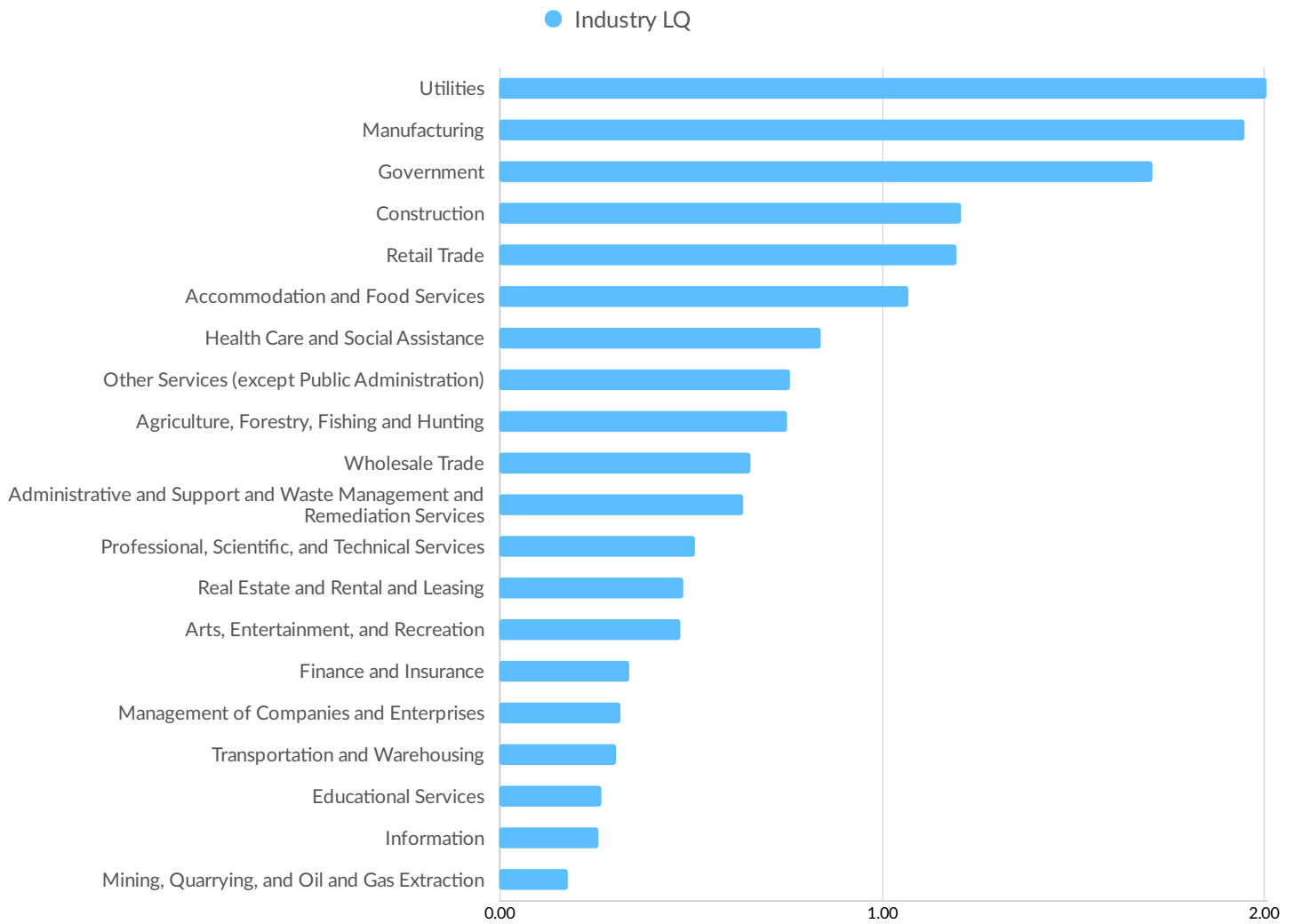

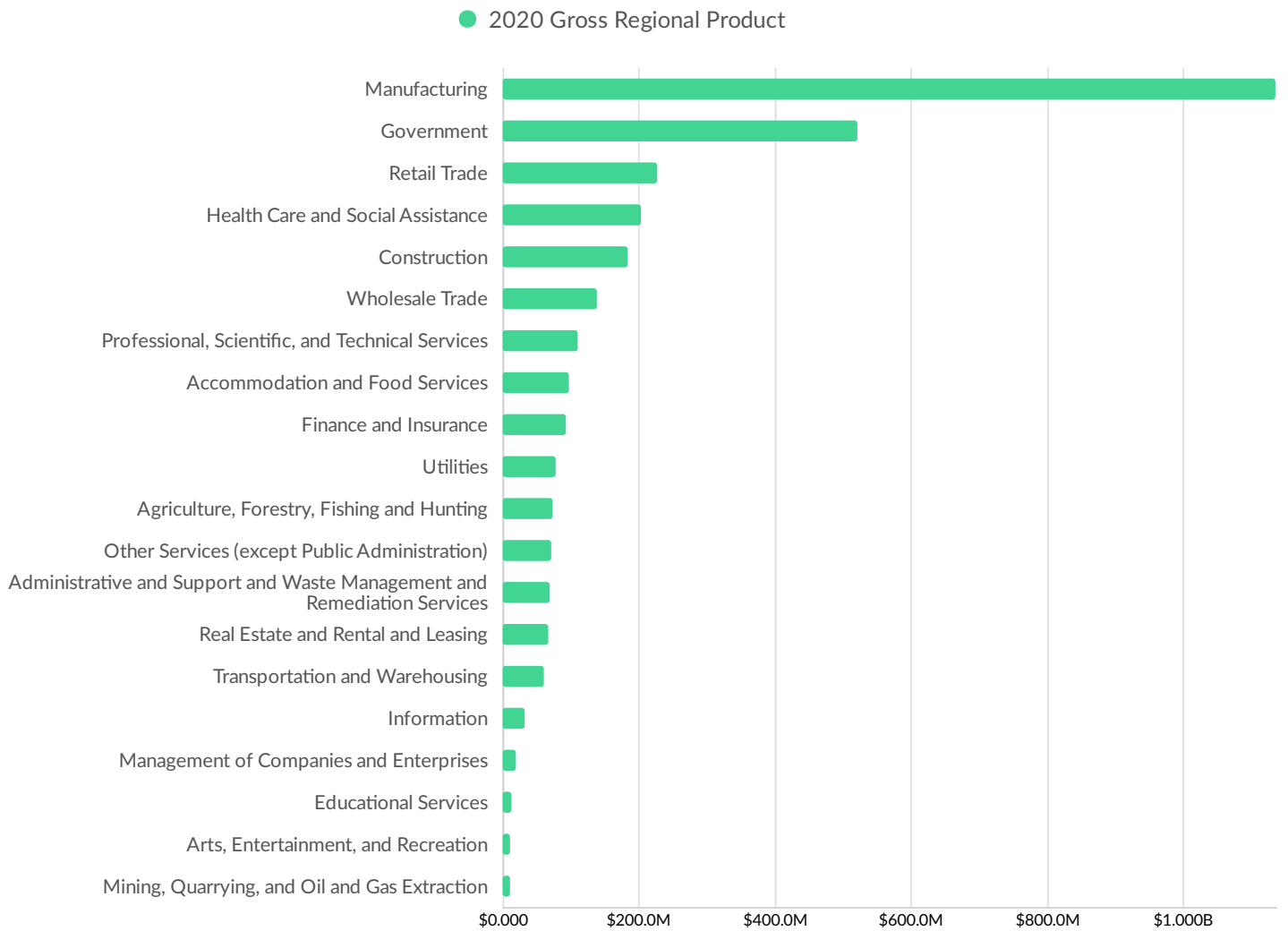

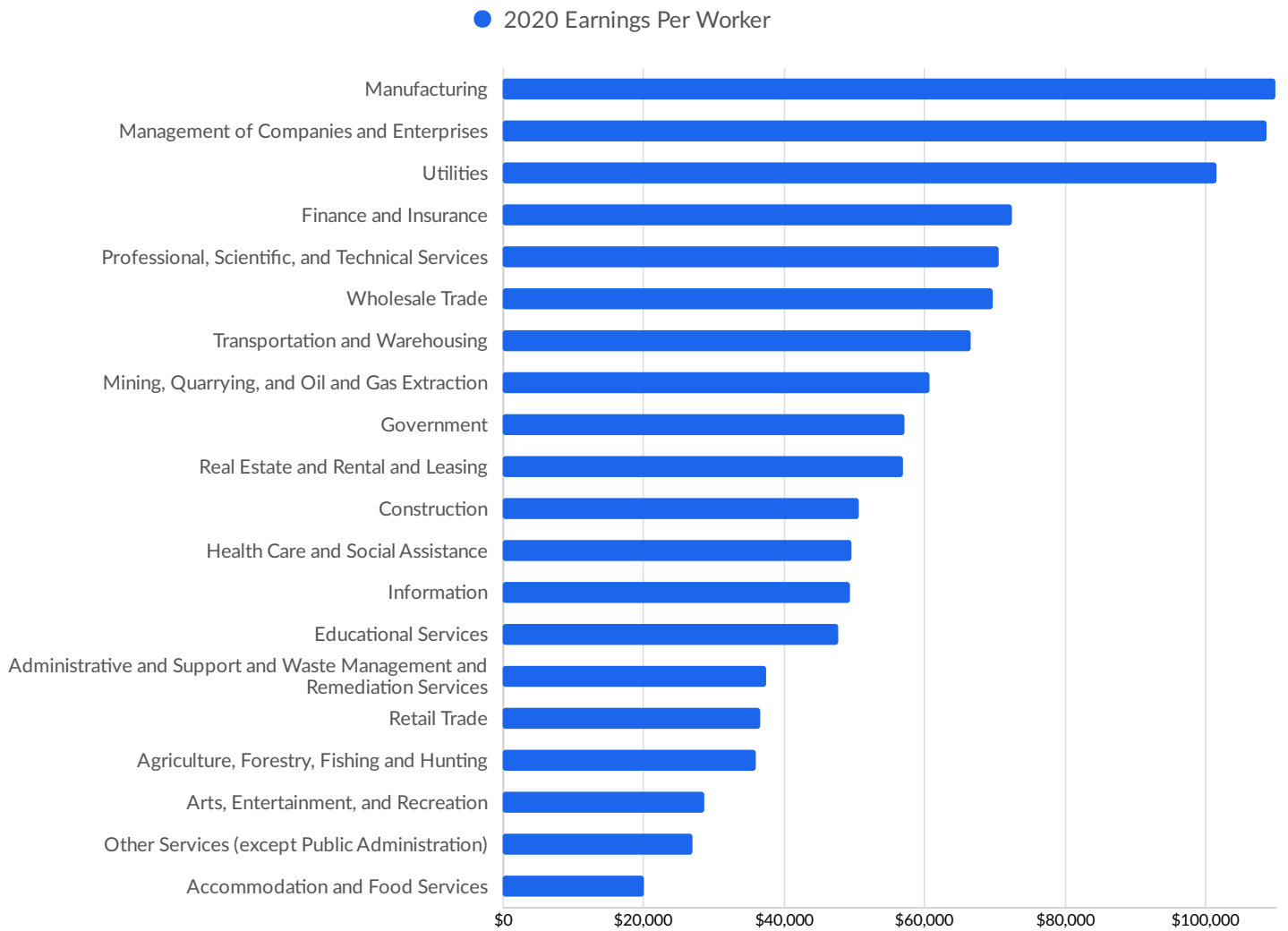

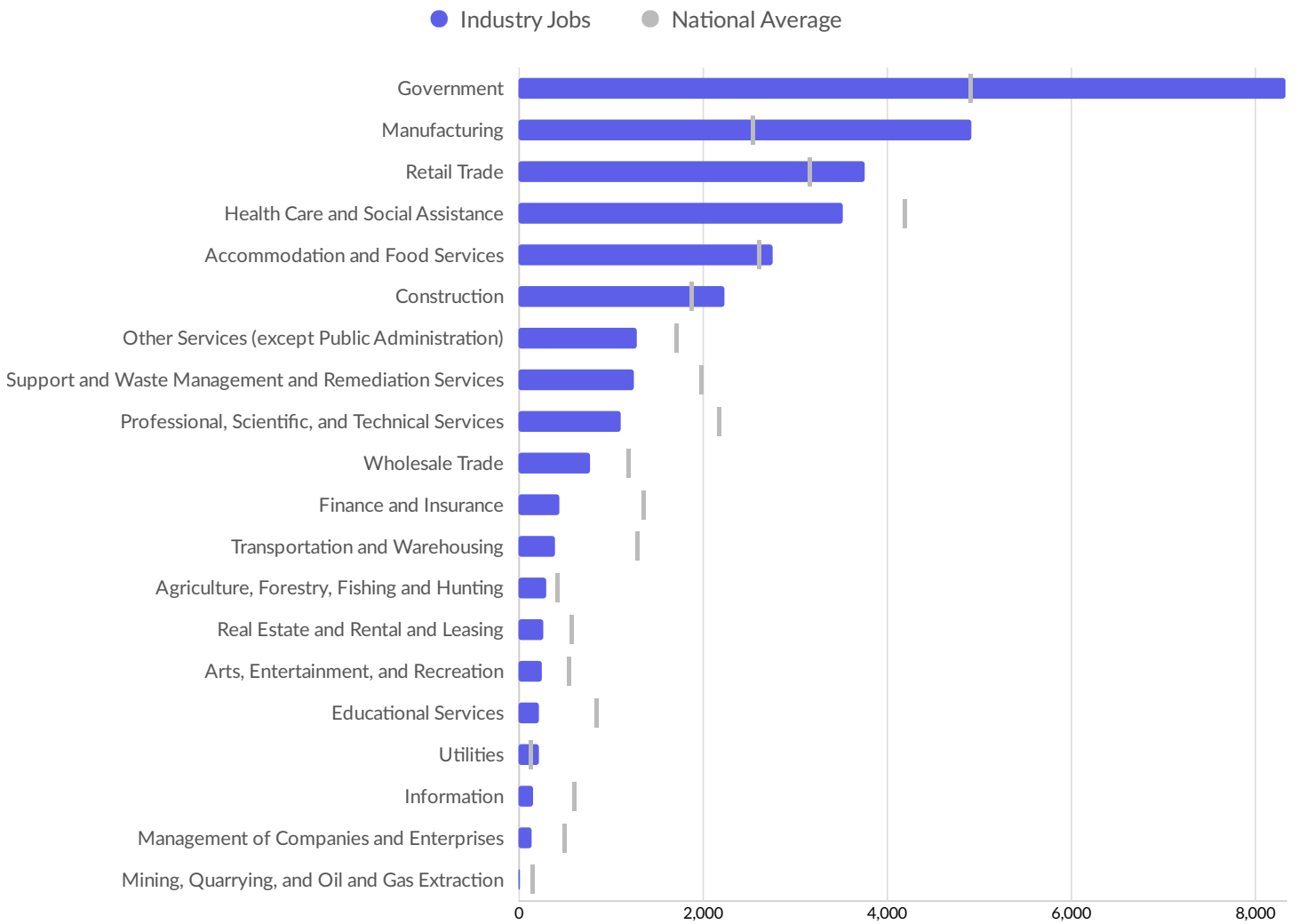

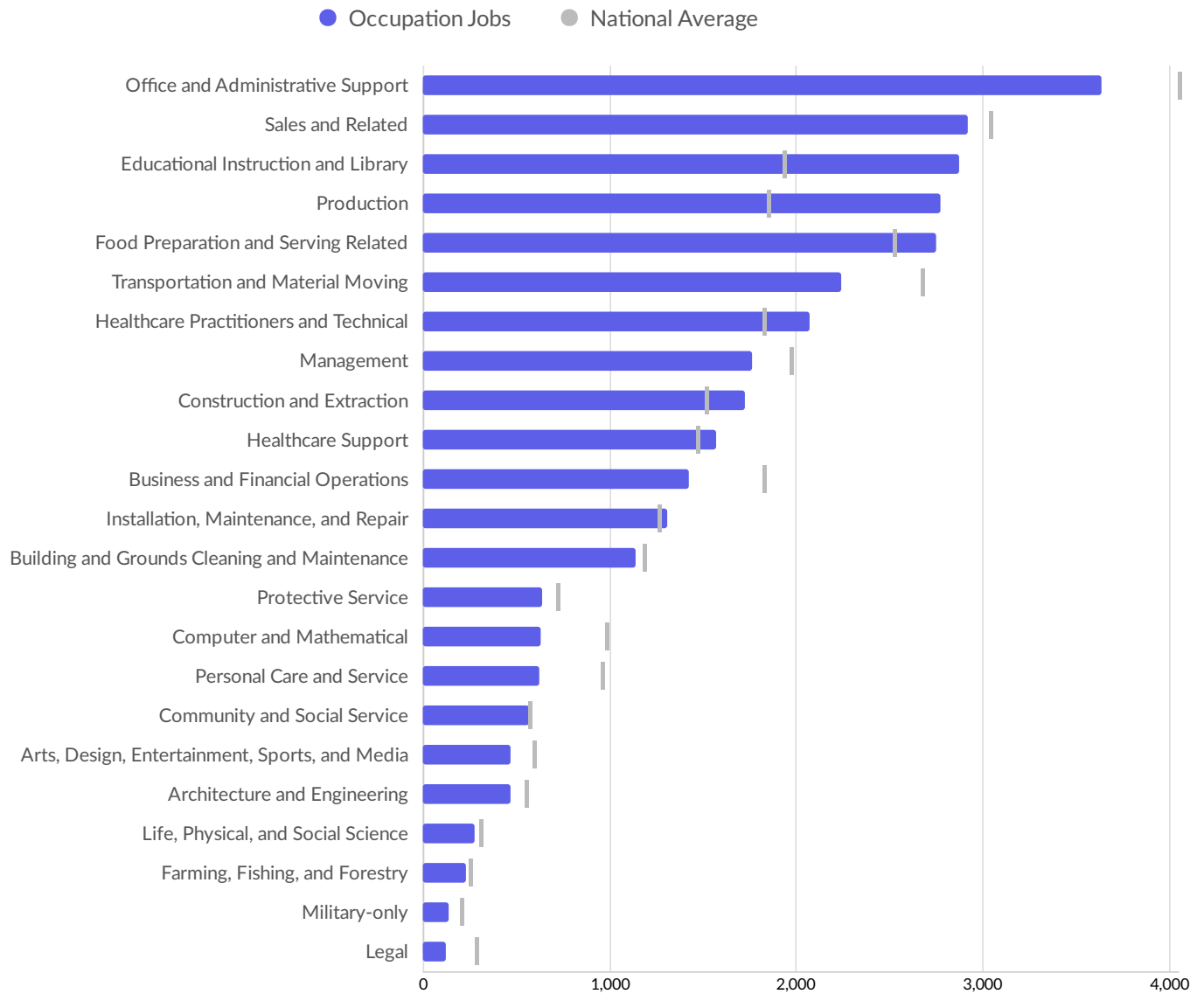

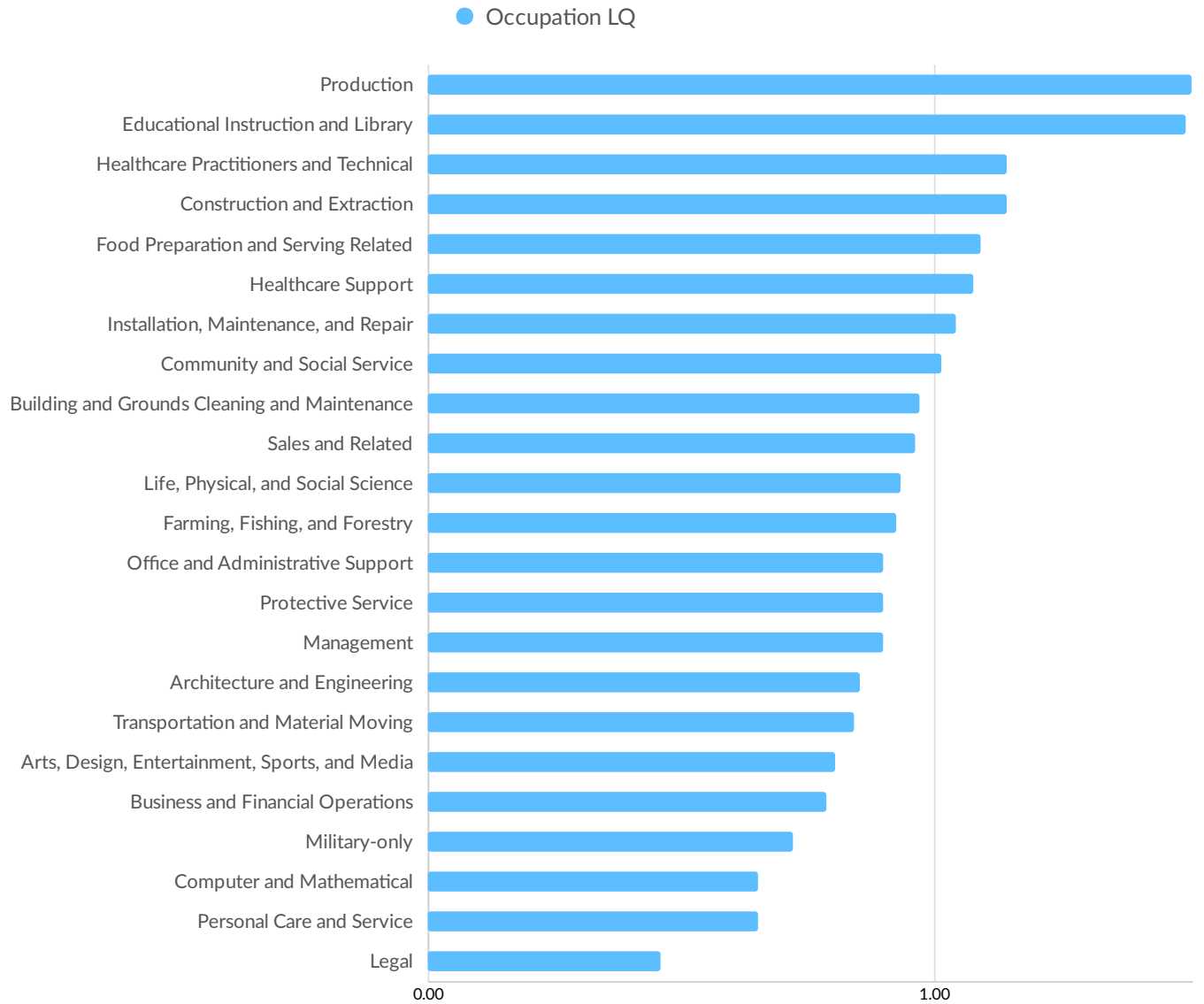

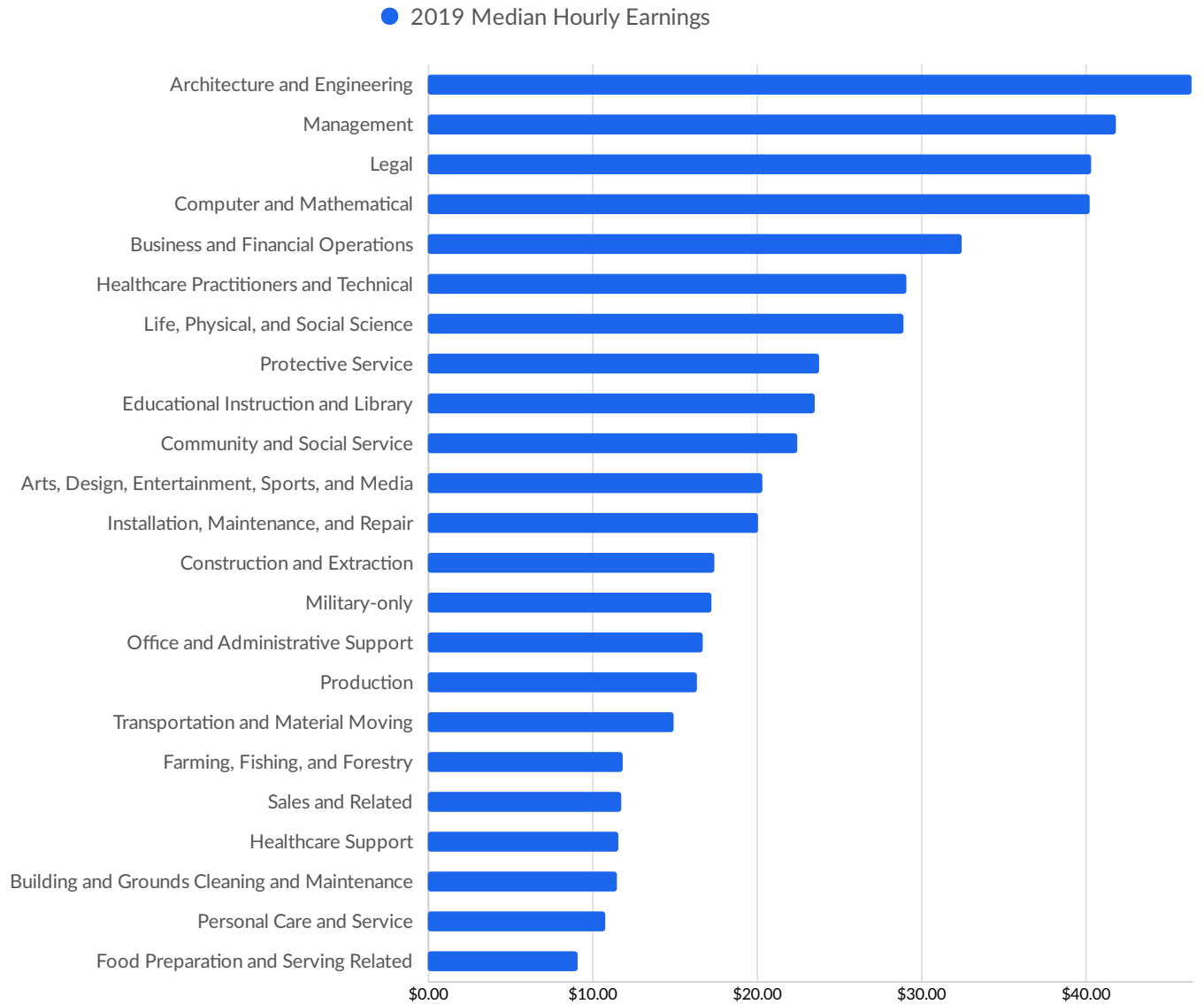

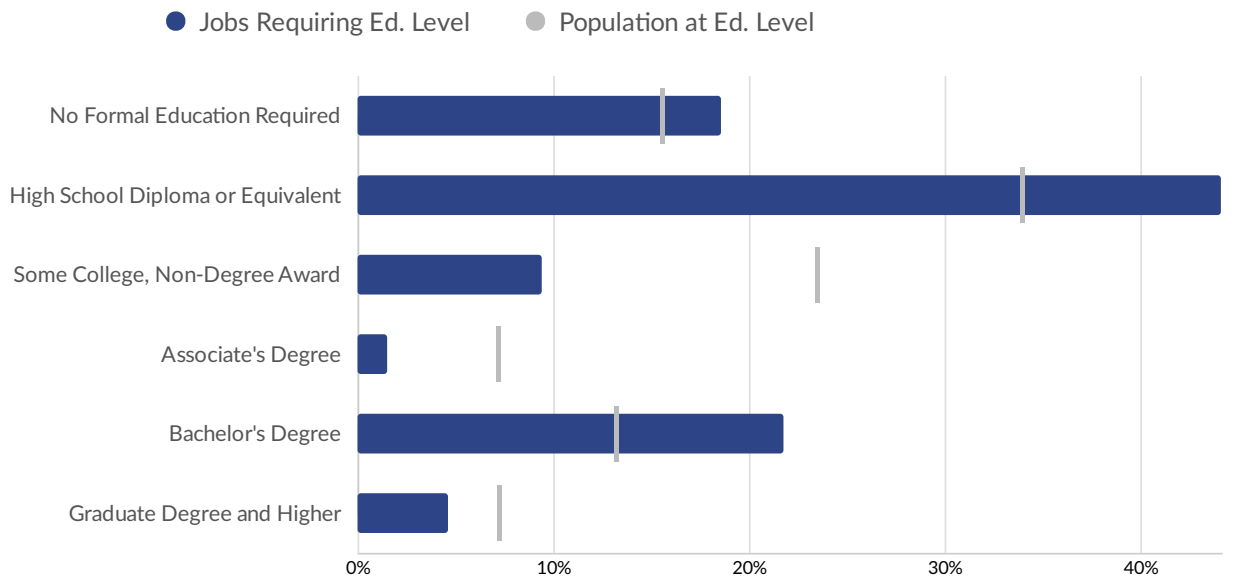

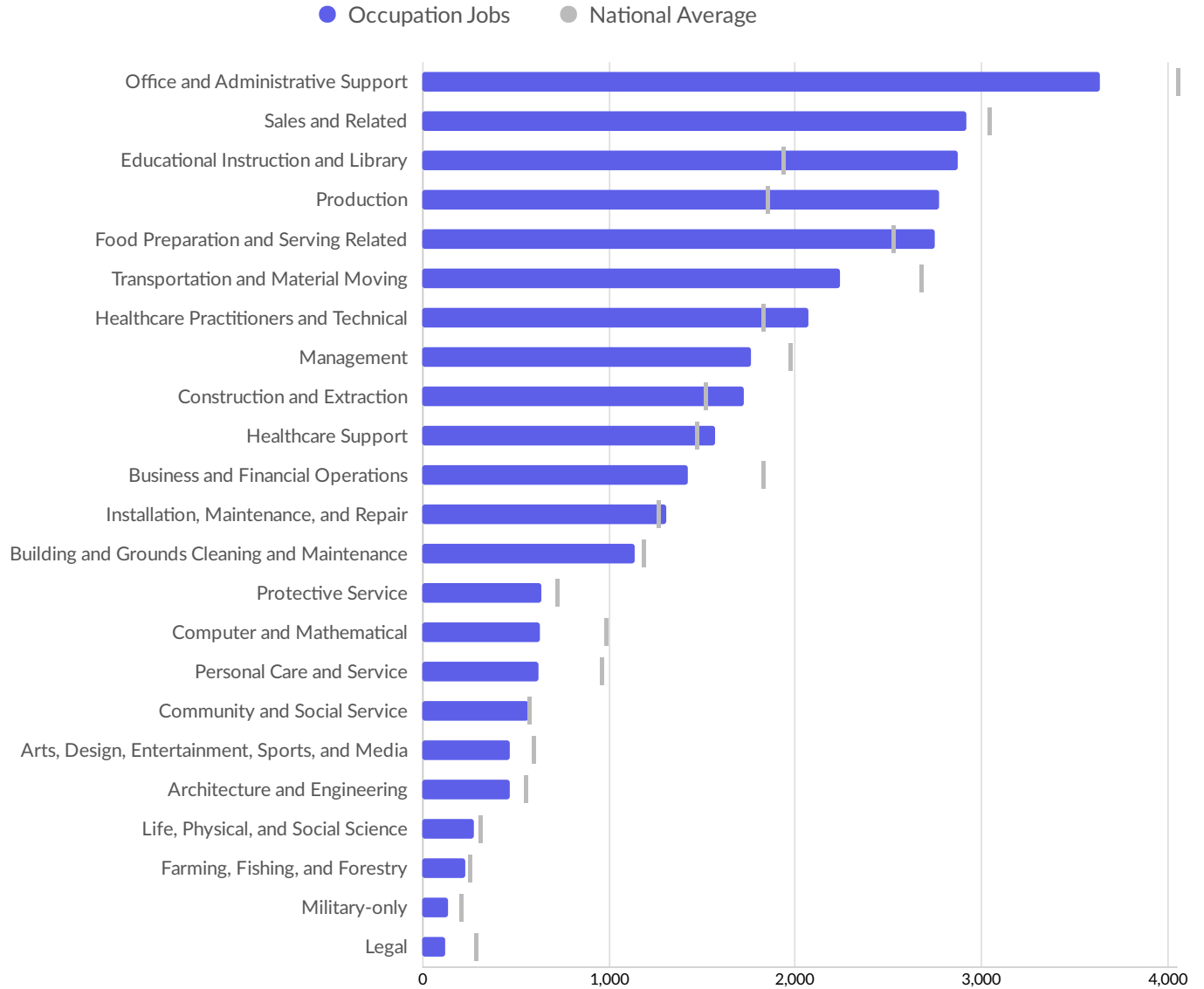
