
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 37.9% since 2017, growing by 46,563. Population is expected to increase by 34.9% between 2022 and 2027, adding 59,126.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 21.7% in Kaufman County, TX from 37,406 to 45,516. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 17.9%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 64.5% to 60.9% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.6% of Kaufman County**, **TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.2% below the national average), and **9.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Warehousing and Storage, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.













### **Job Trends**







#### Millennials


Kaufman County, TX has 34,682 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 32,227.






#### **Veterans**

Retirement risk is low in Kaufman County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 46,894 people 55 or older, while there are 34,663 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is high in Kaufman County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 64,202 racially diverse people, while there are 72,988 here.




#### **Property Crime**










### **Top Industry Employment Concentration**










### **Top Occupation Employment Concentration**




