- The top three industries in 2022 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

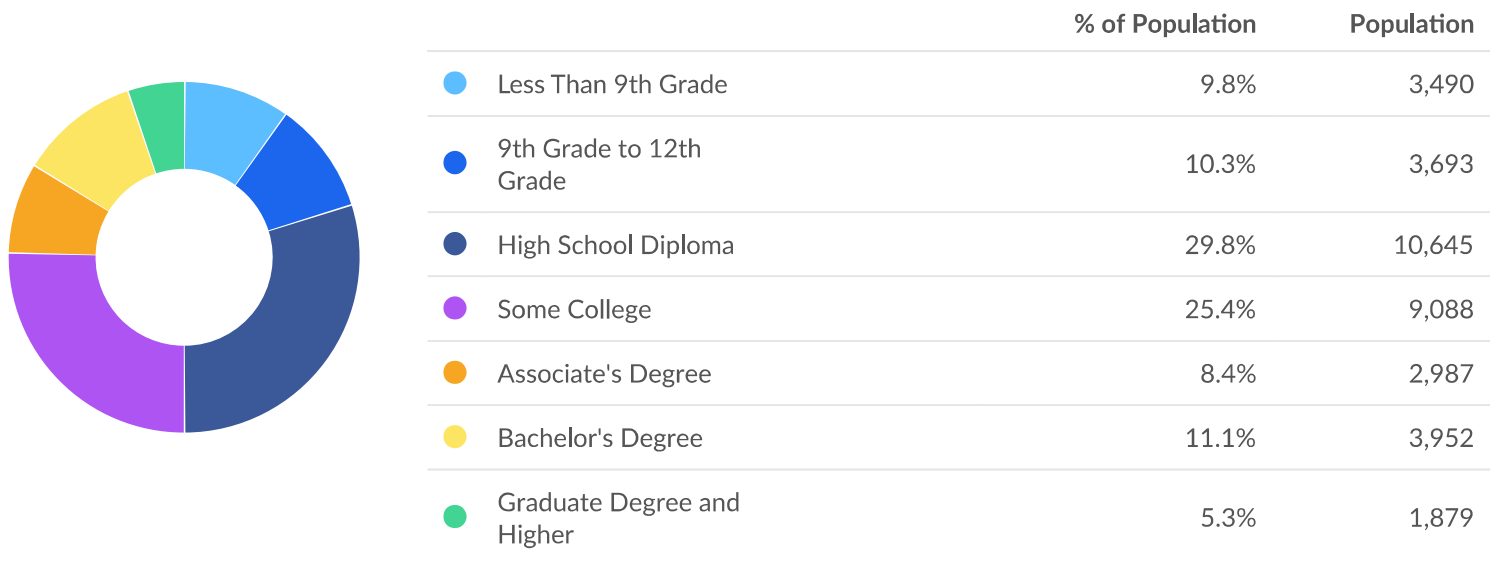

Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



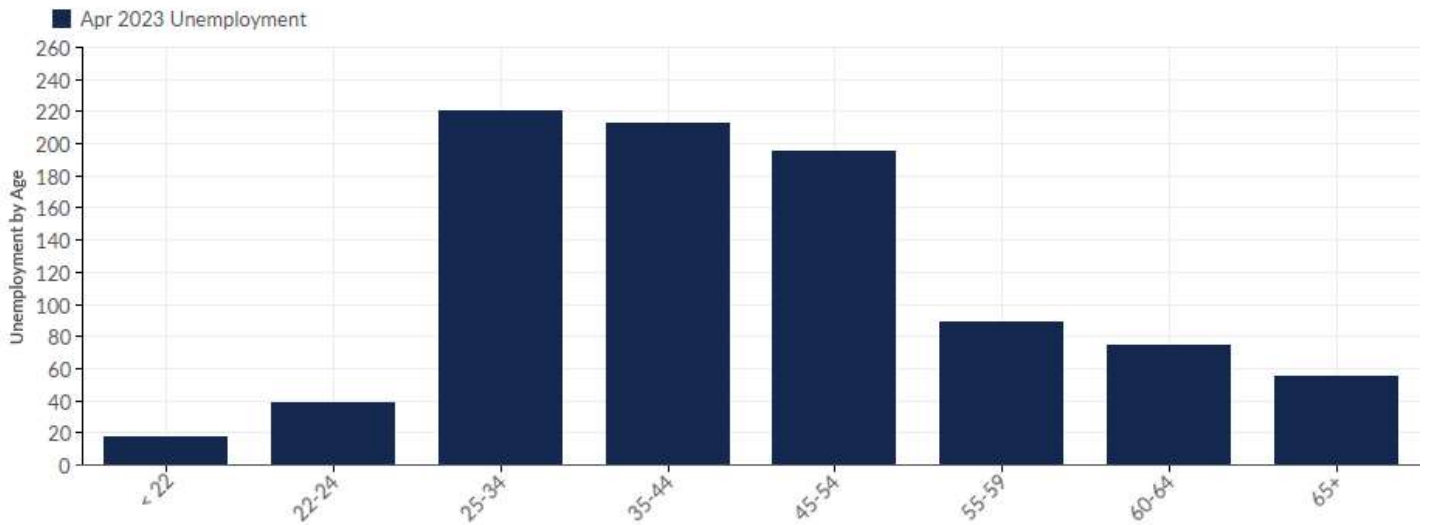
Educational Attainment

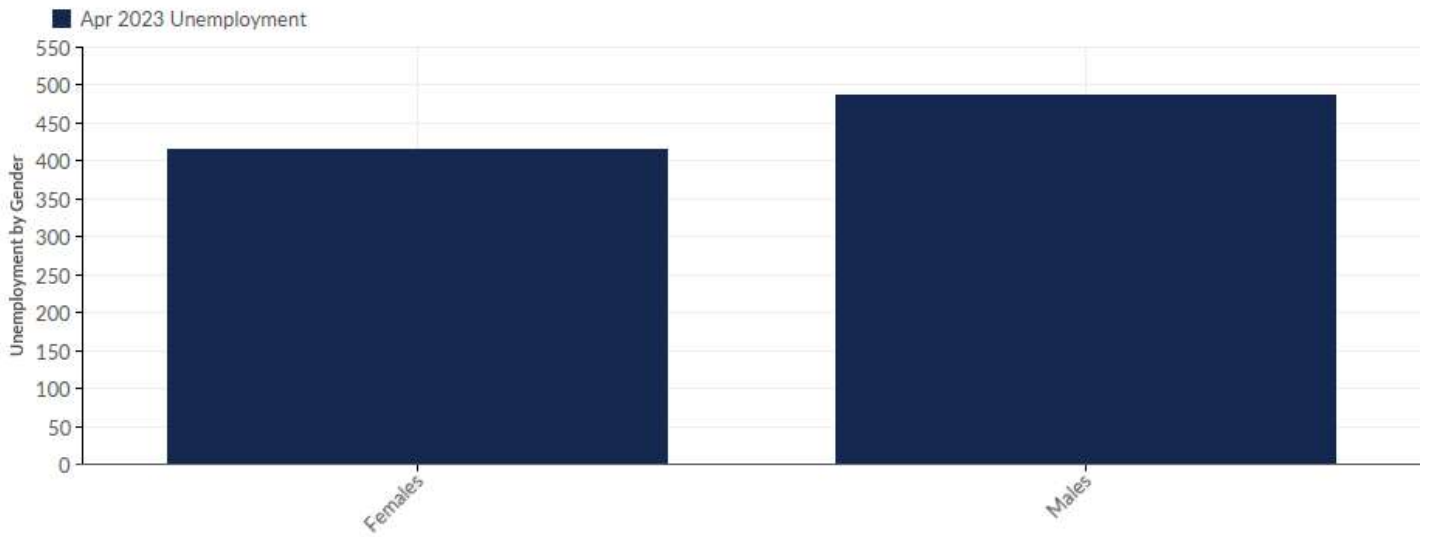

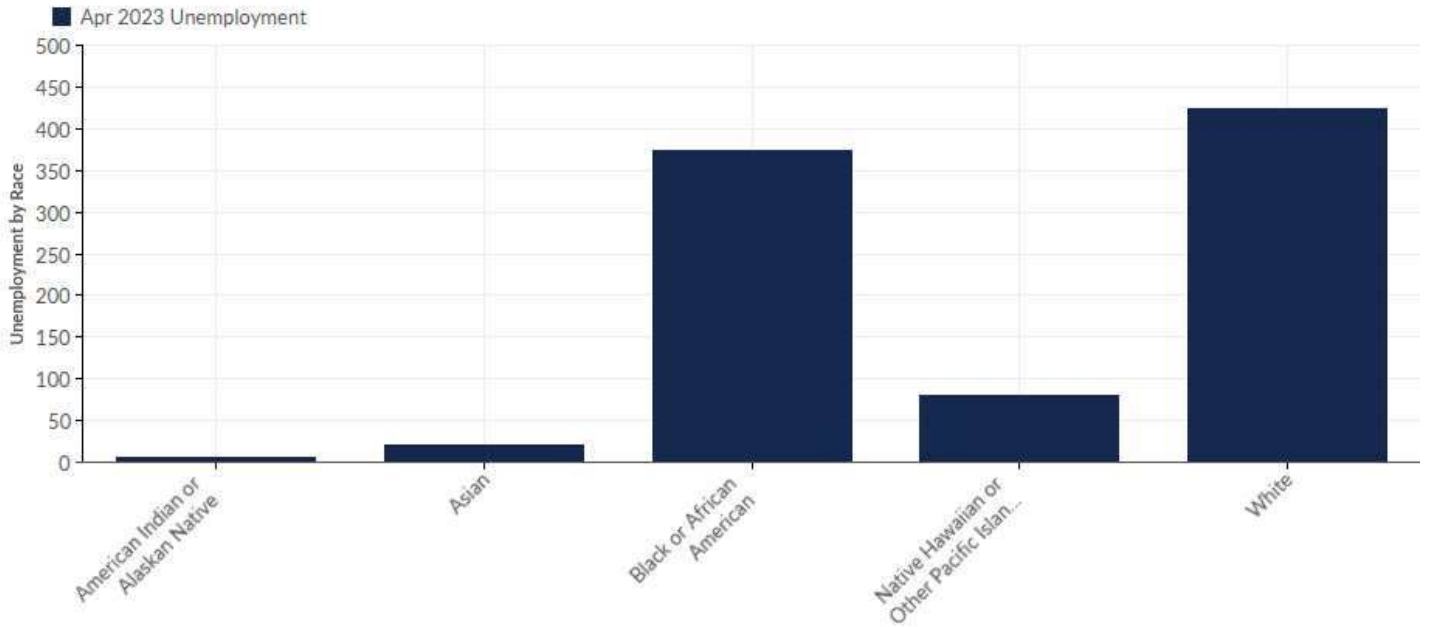

Unemployment by Gender



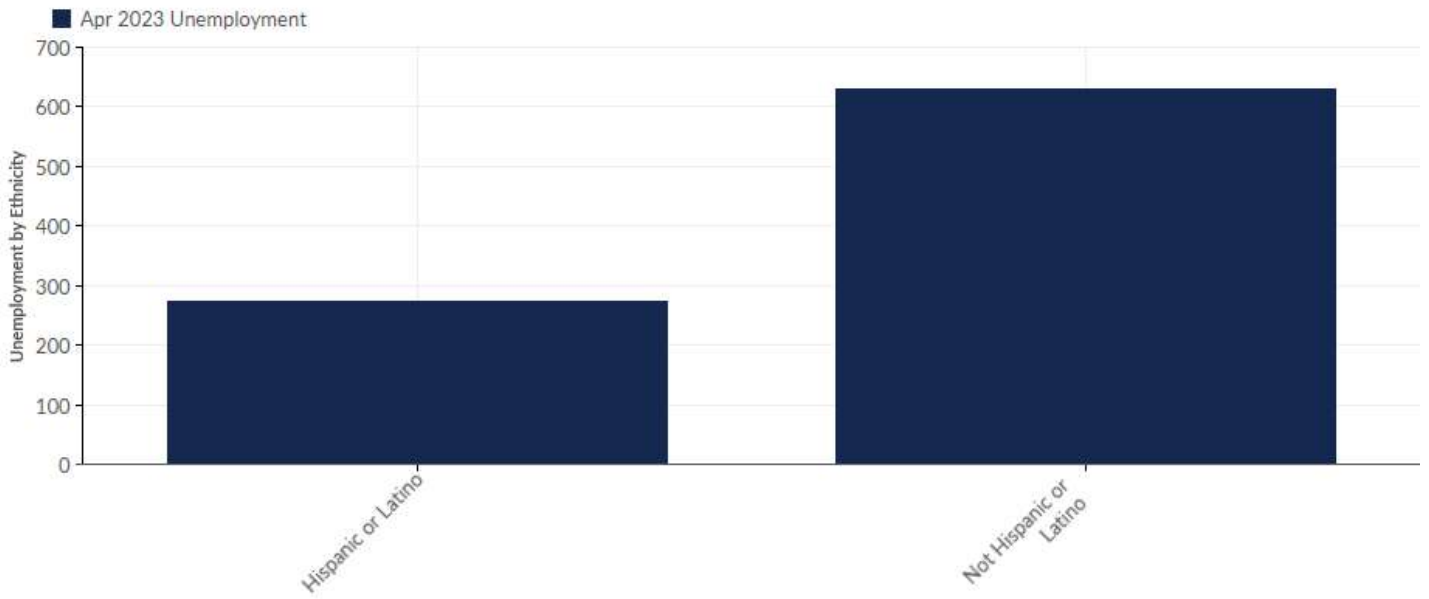

Unemployment by Ethnicity

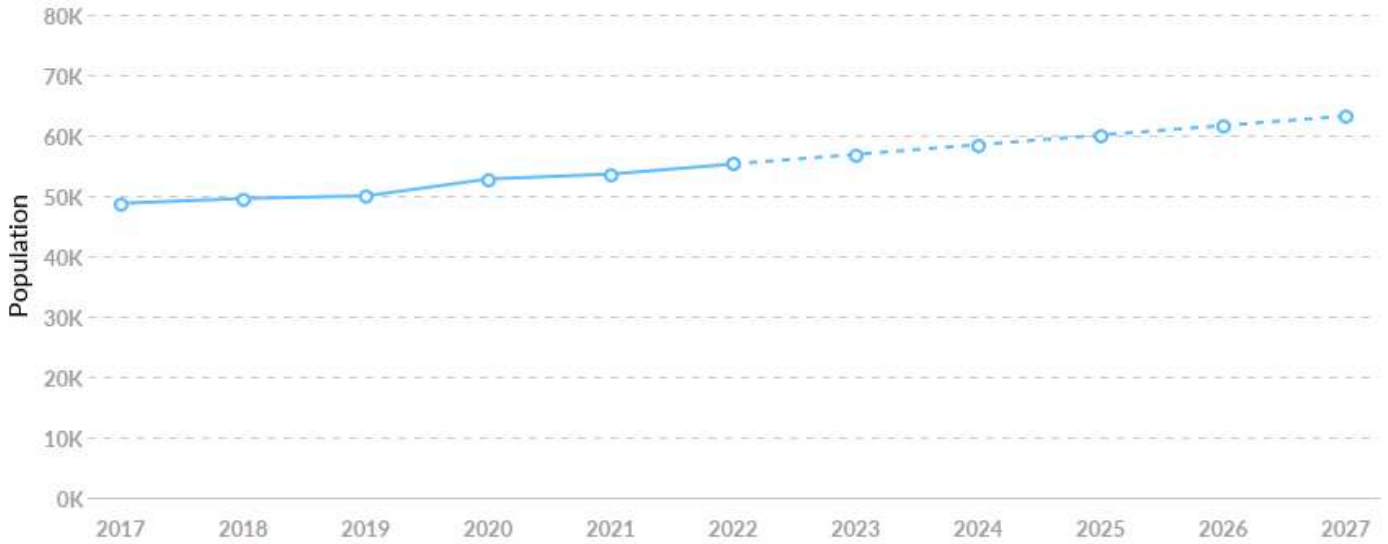

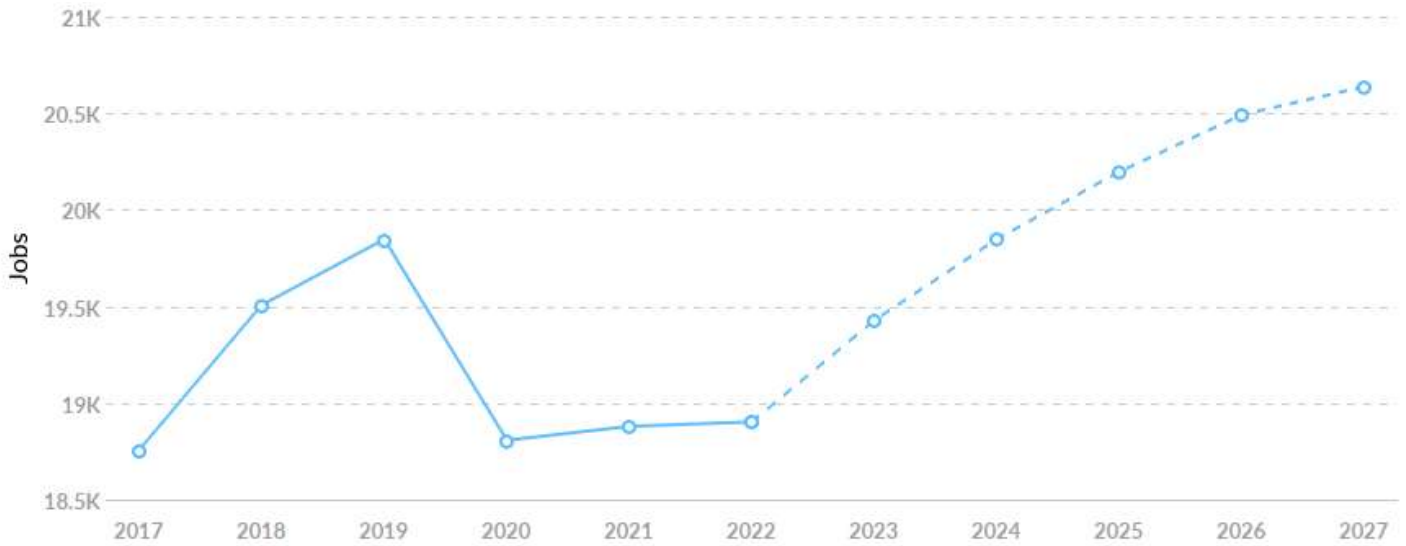

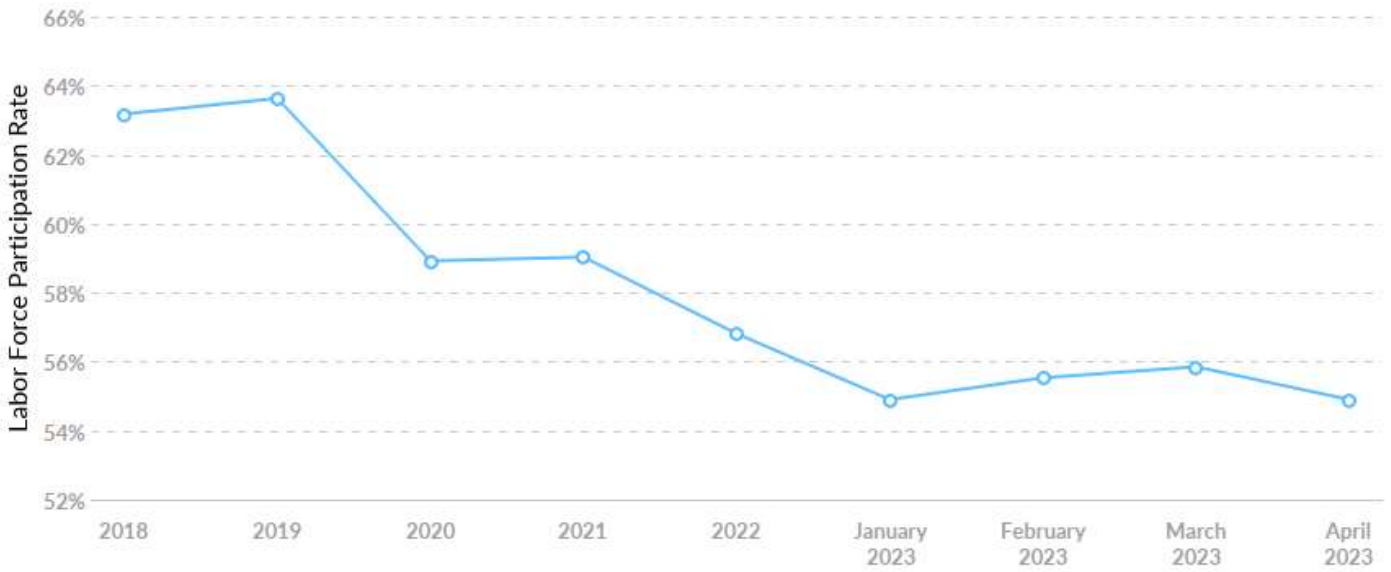
Job Trends

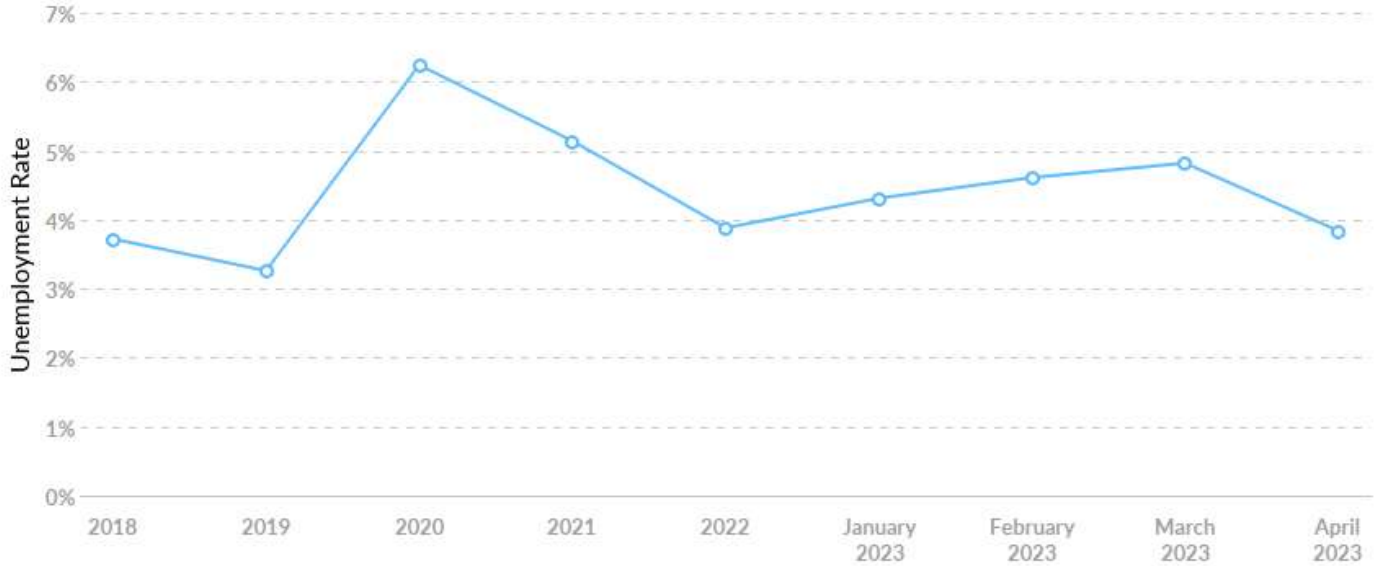

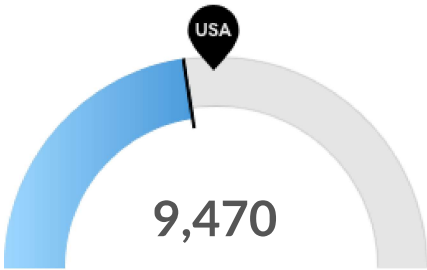
Unemployment Rate Trends

Navarro County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.84%, **increasing from 3.72%** 5 years before.



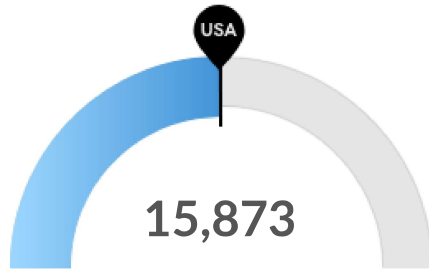

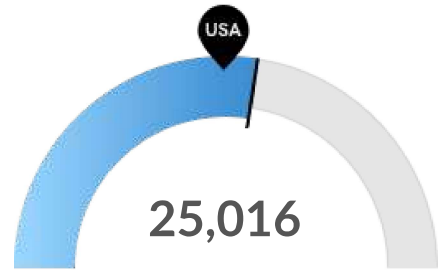
Millennials

Navarro County, TX has 9,470 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 10,947.



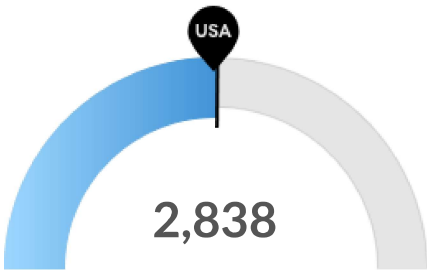
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Navarro County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 15,929 people 55 or older, while there are 15,873 here.



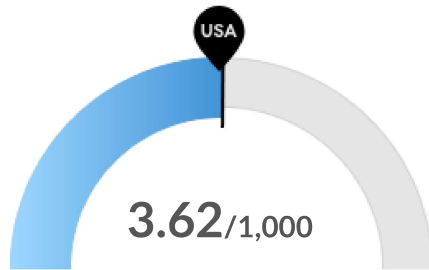
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Navarro County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 21,808 racially diverse people, while there are 25,016 here.



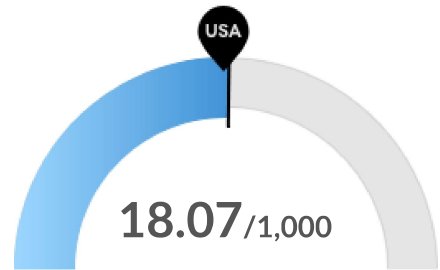
Veterans

Navarro County, TX has 3.62 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

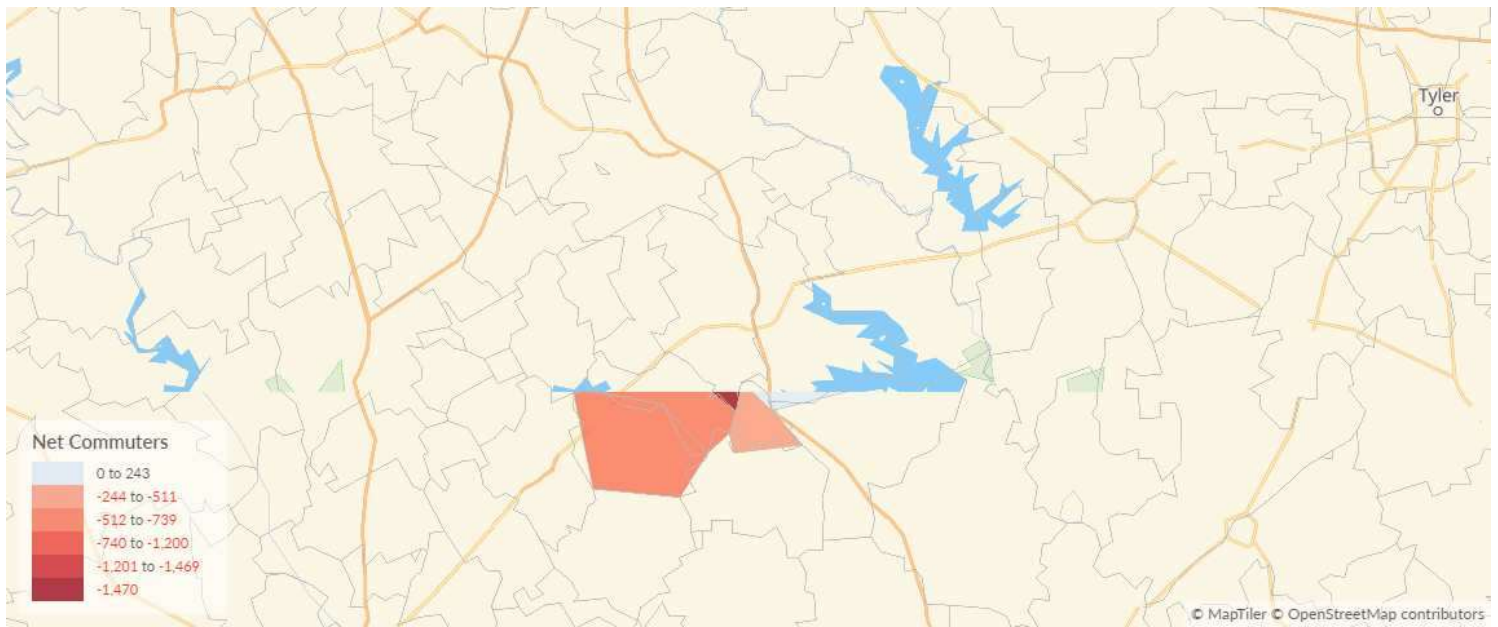


Property Crime

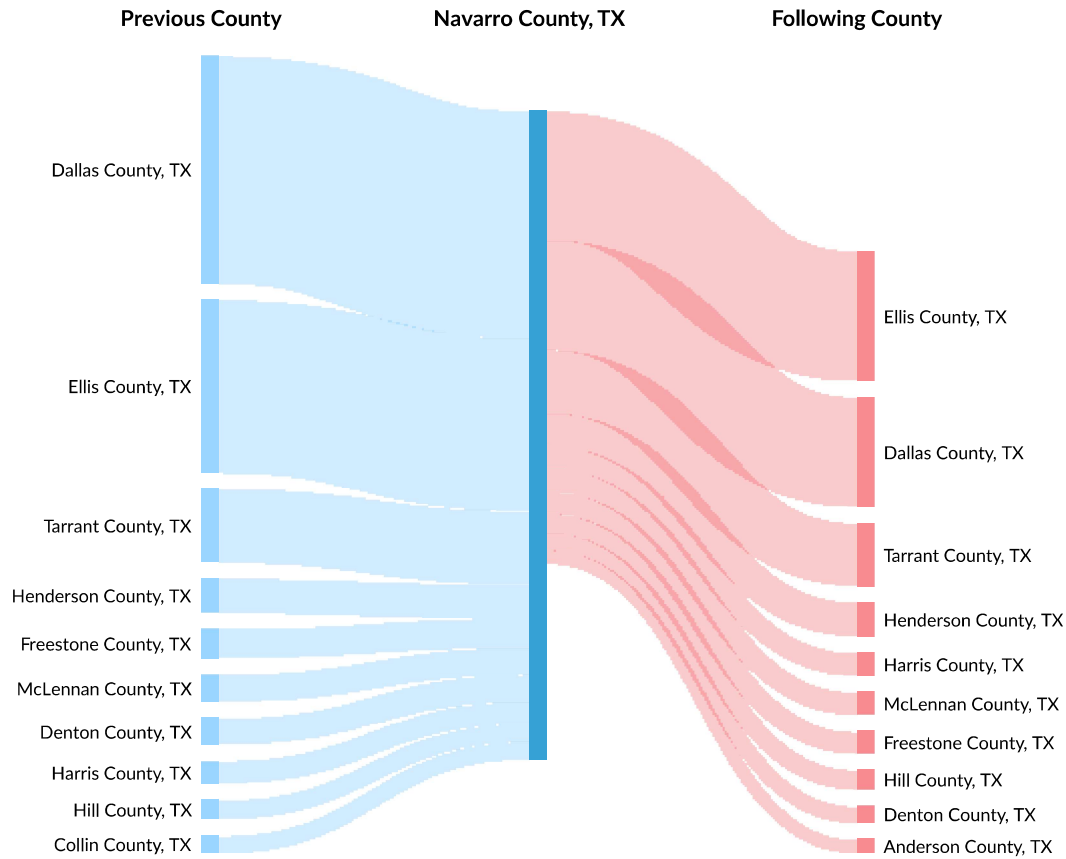

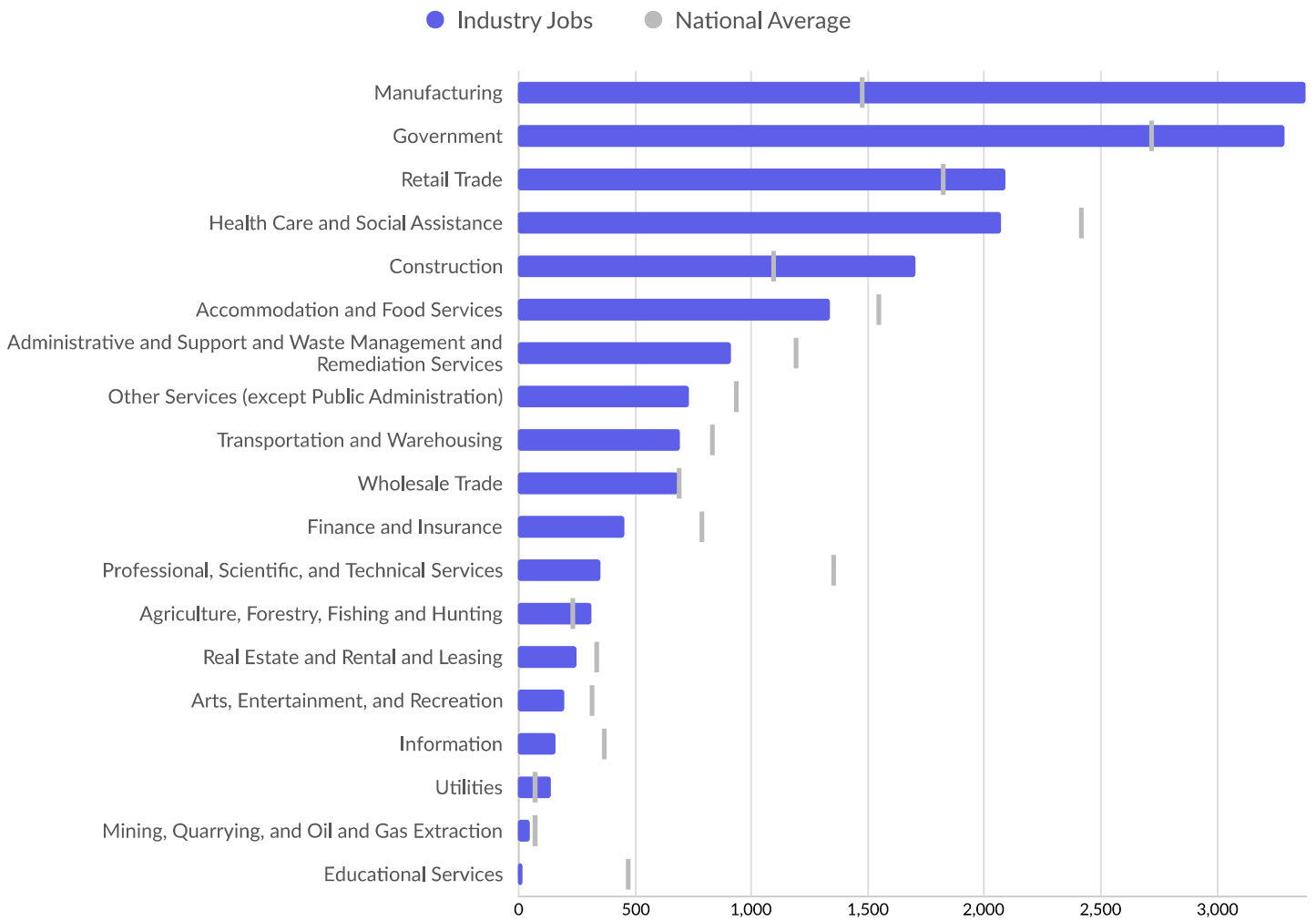

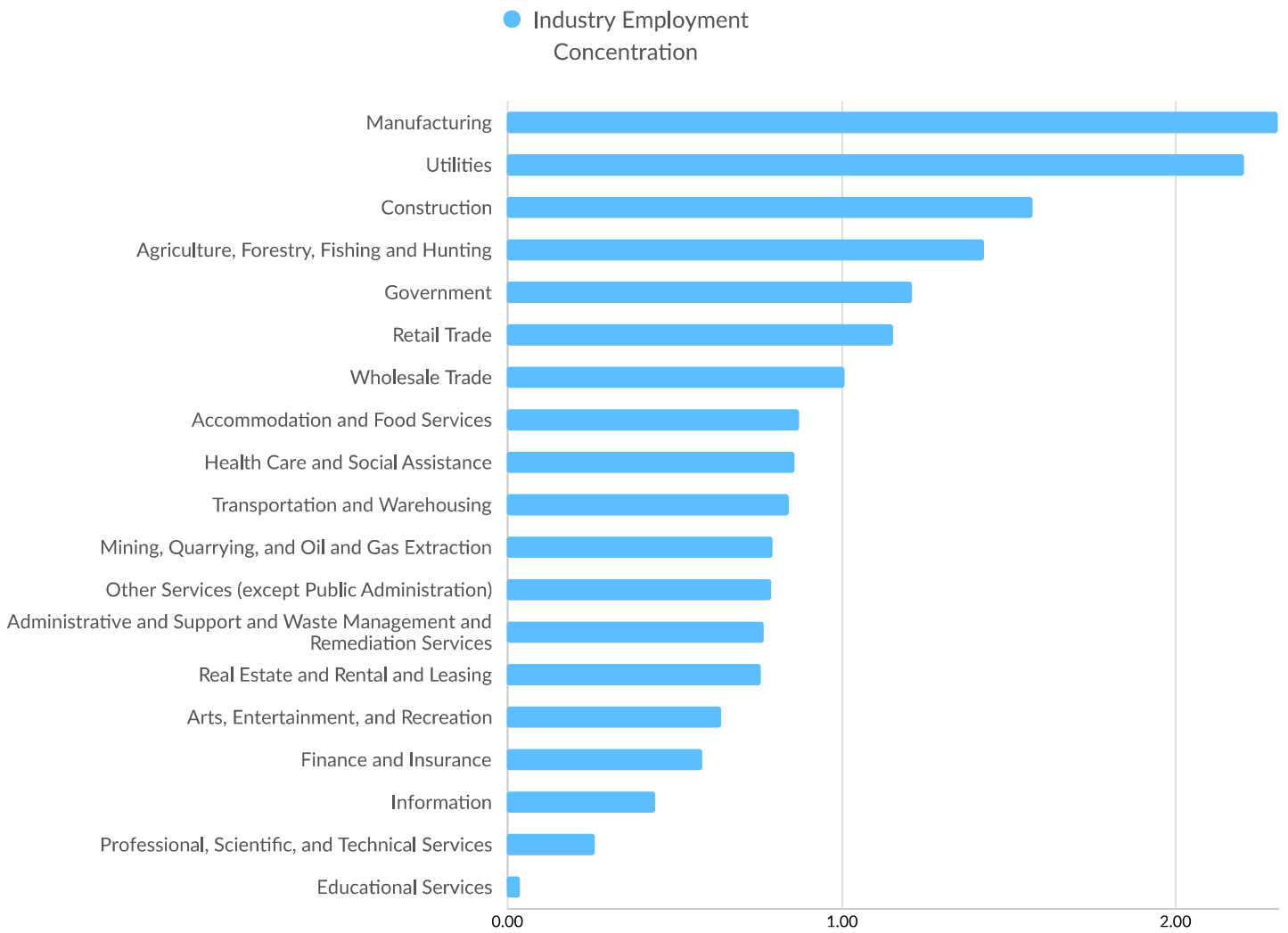

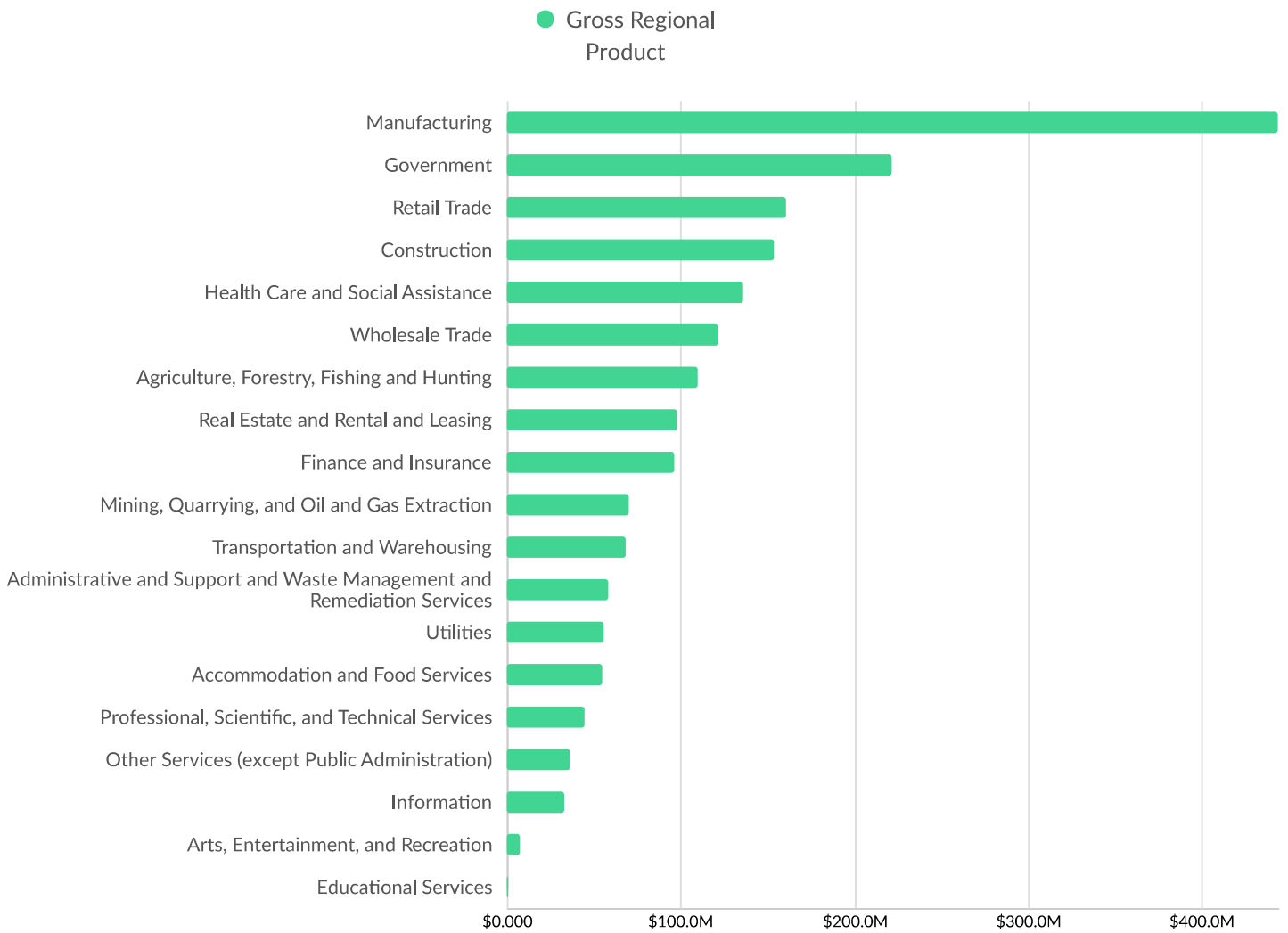
Top Growing Industries



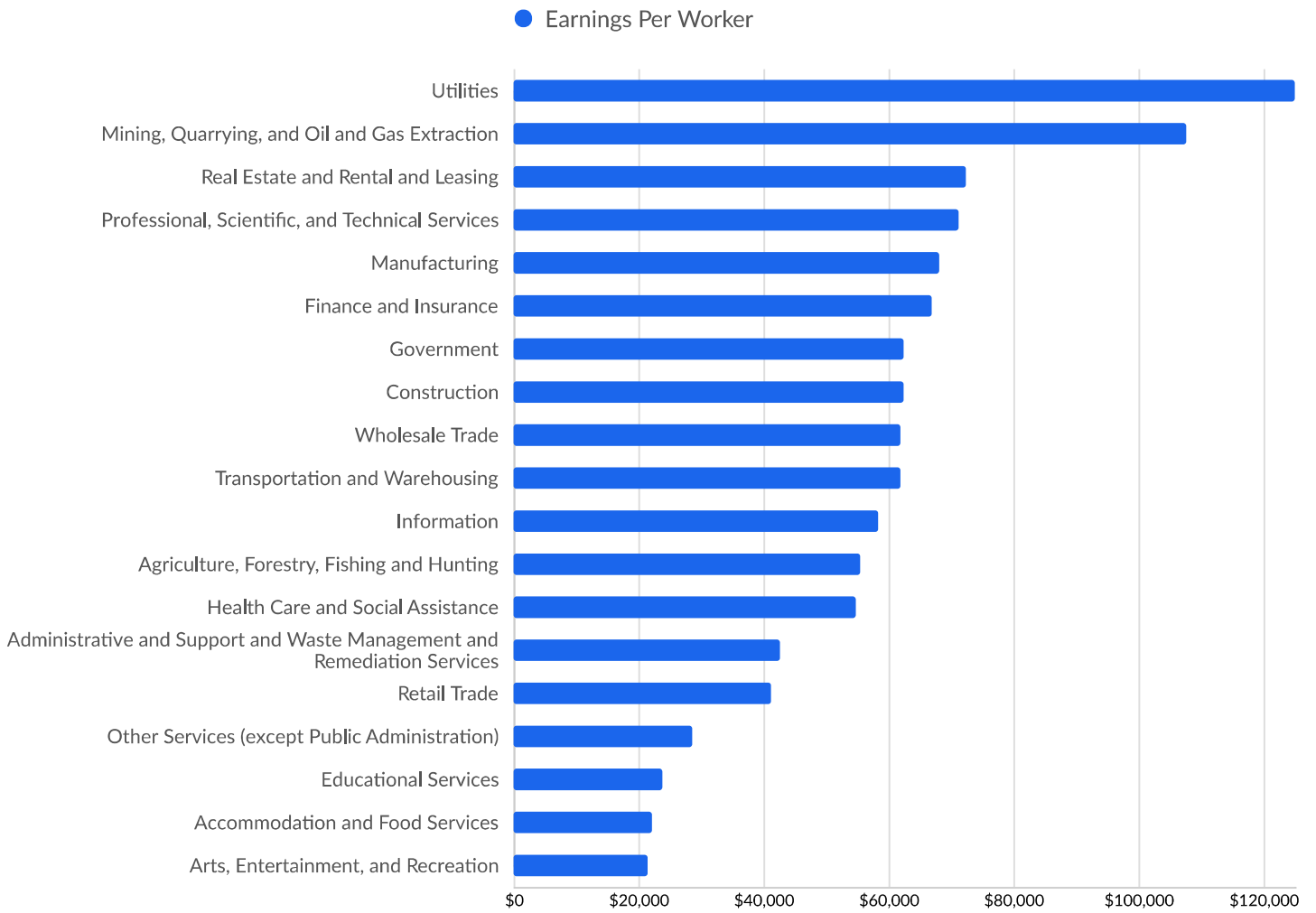
Top Industry Employment Concentration

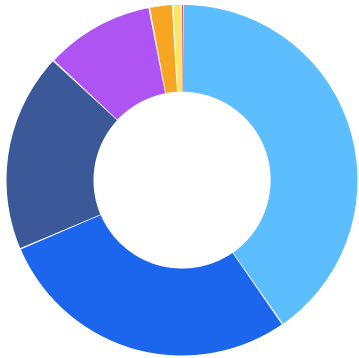

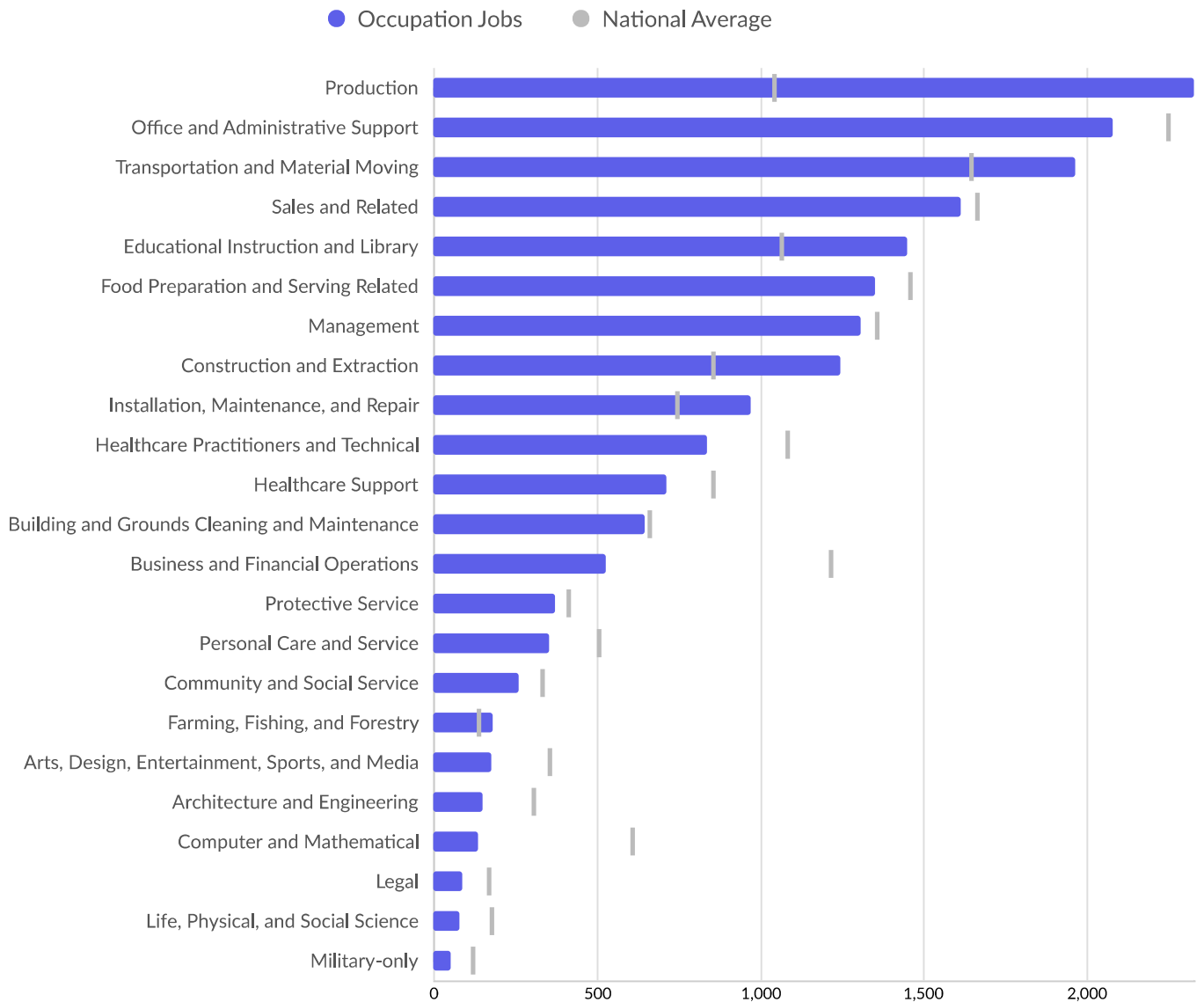

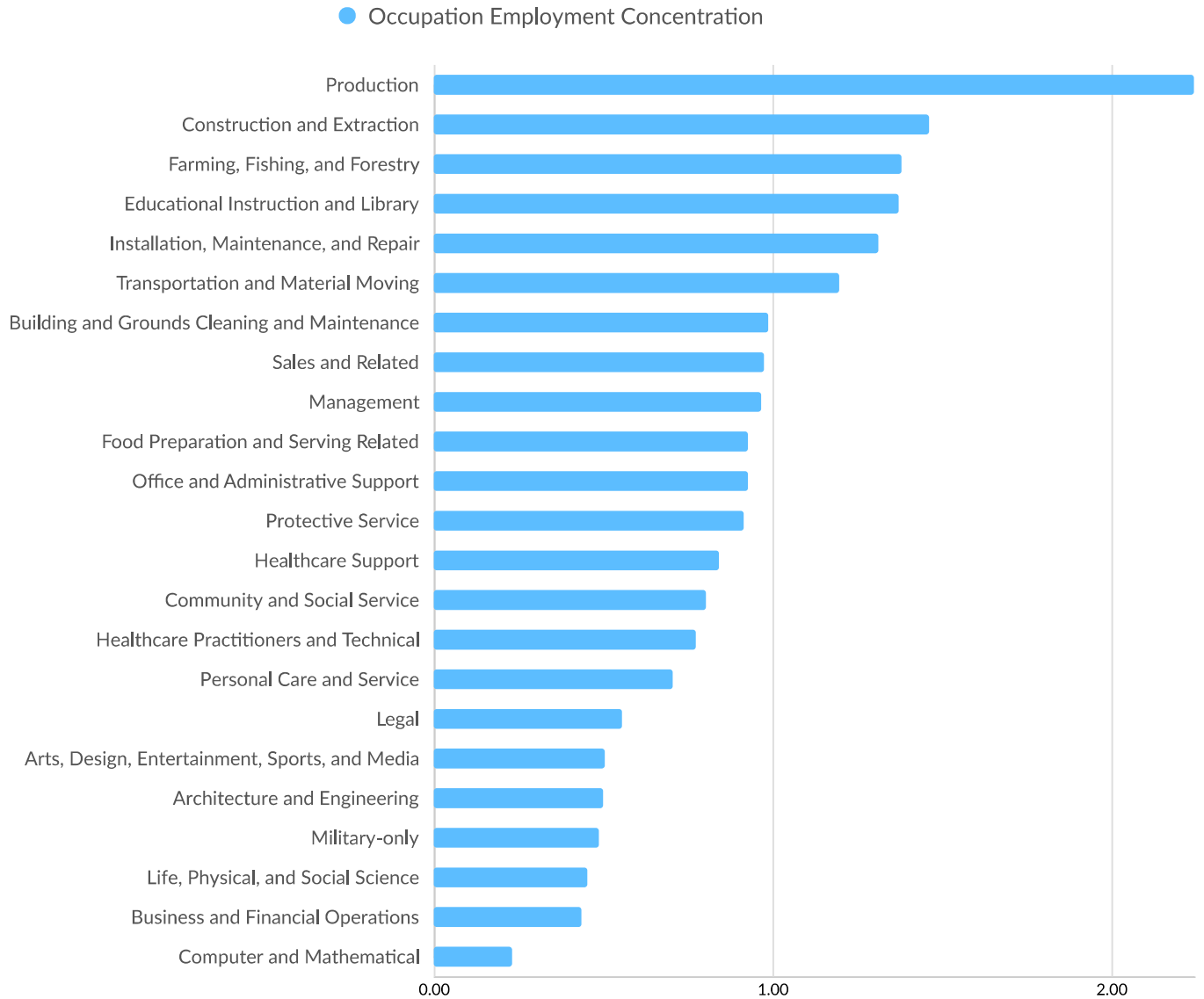

Top Growing Occupations



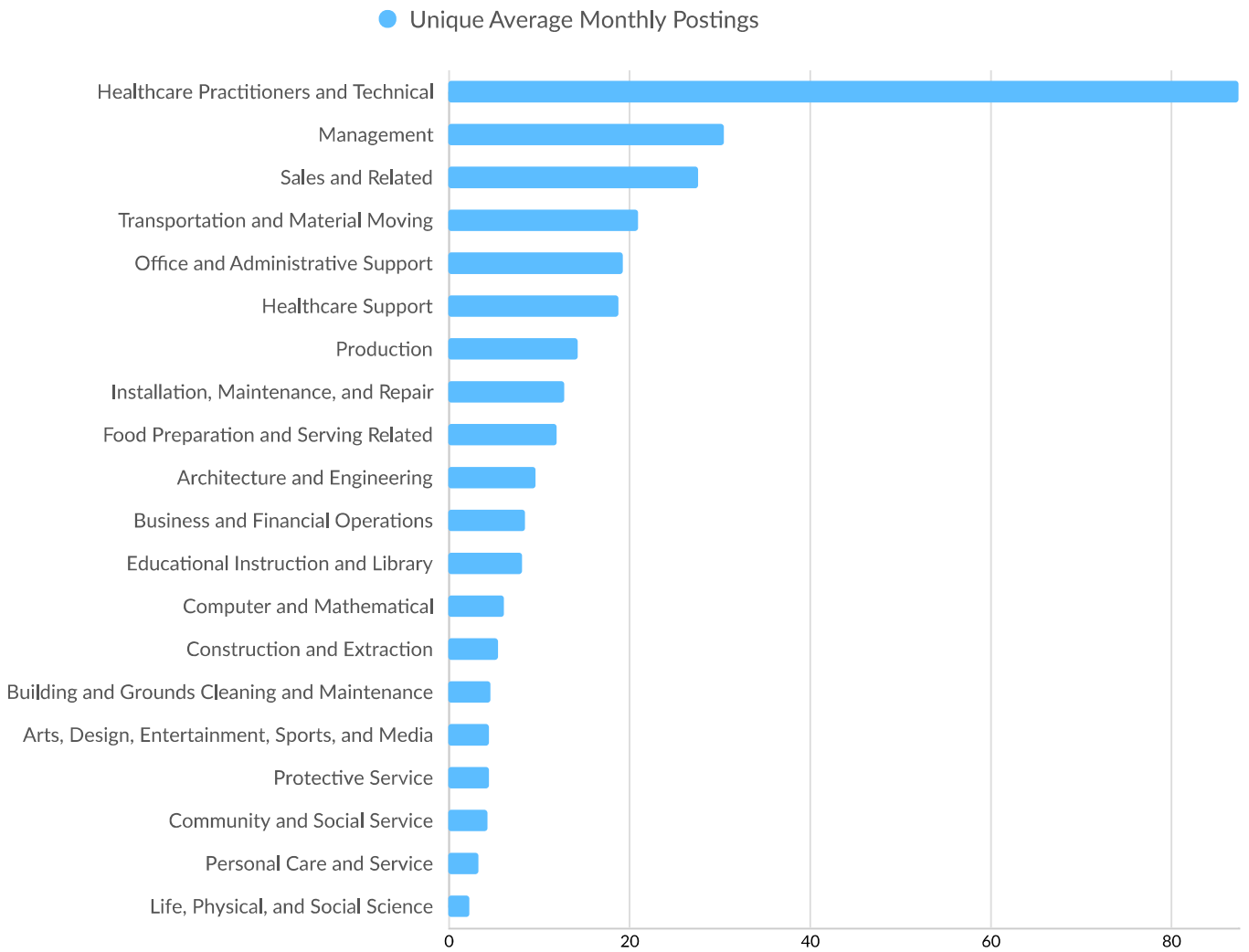
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



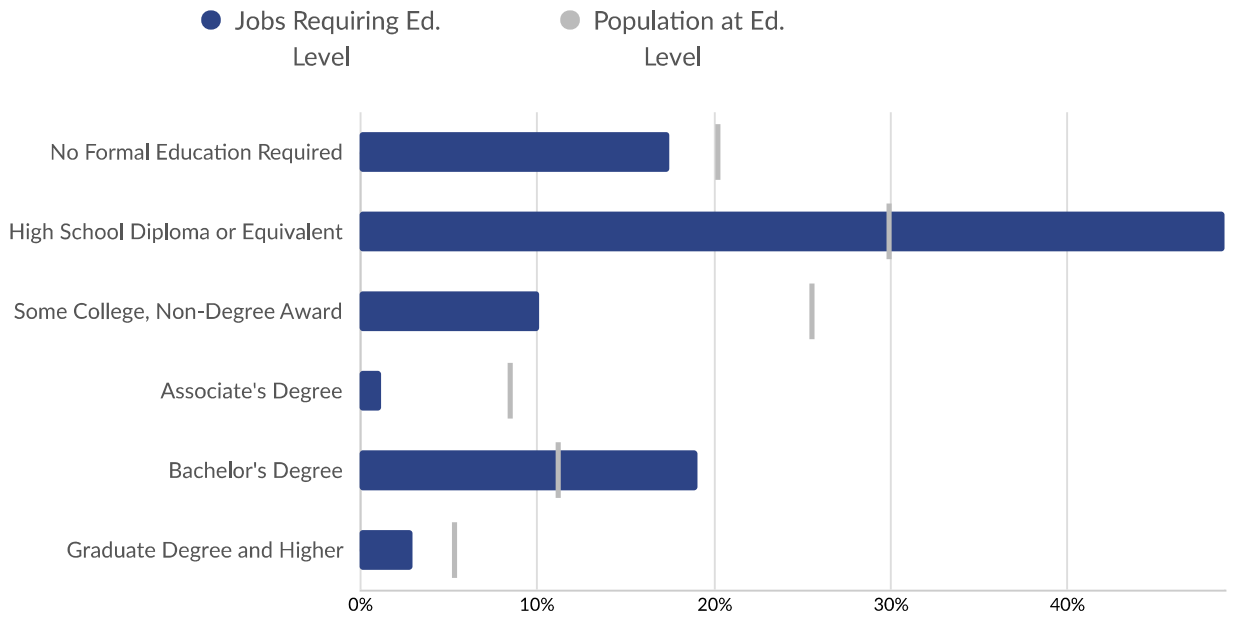
Top Occupation Earnings

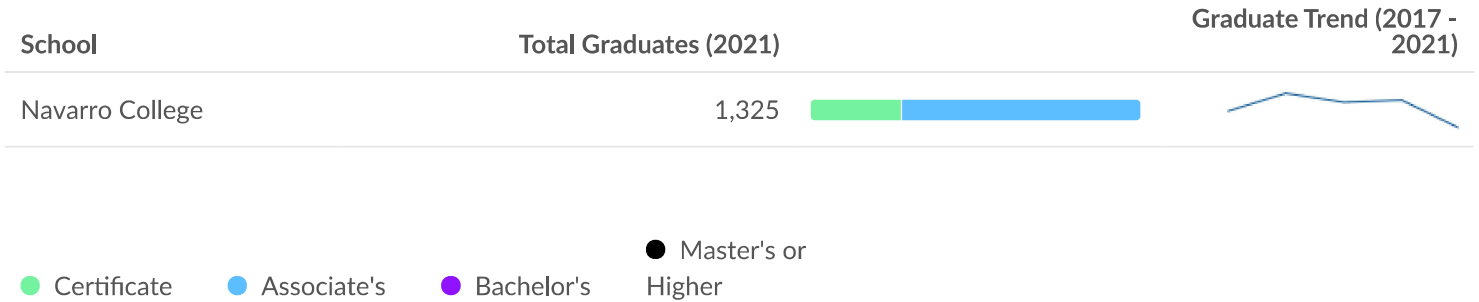
