- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 25.1% in Rockwall County, TX from 35,126 to 43,926. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.8% by 21.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 65.6% to 64.3% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **27.7% of Rockwall County, TX residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.9% above the national average), and **9.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.









Unemployment by Ethnicity










Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends

Rockwall County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.33%, increasing from 3.25% 5 years before.














Top Industry Employment Concentration





Top Occupation Employment Concentration




