- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.

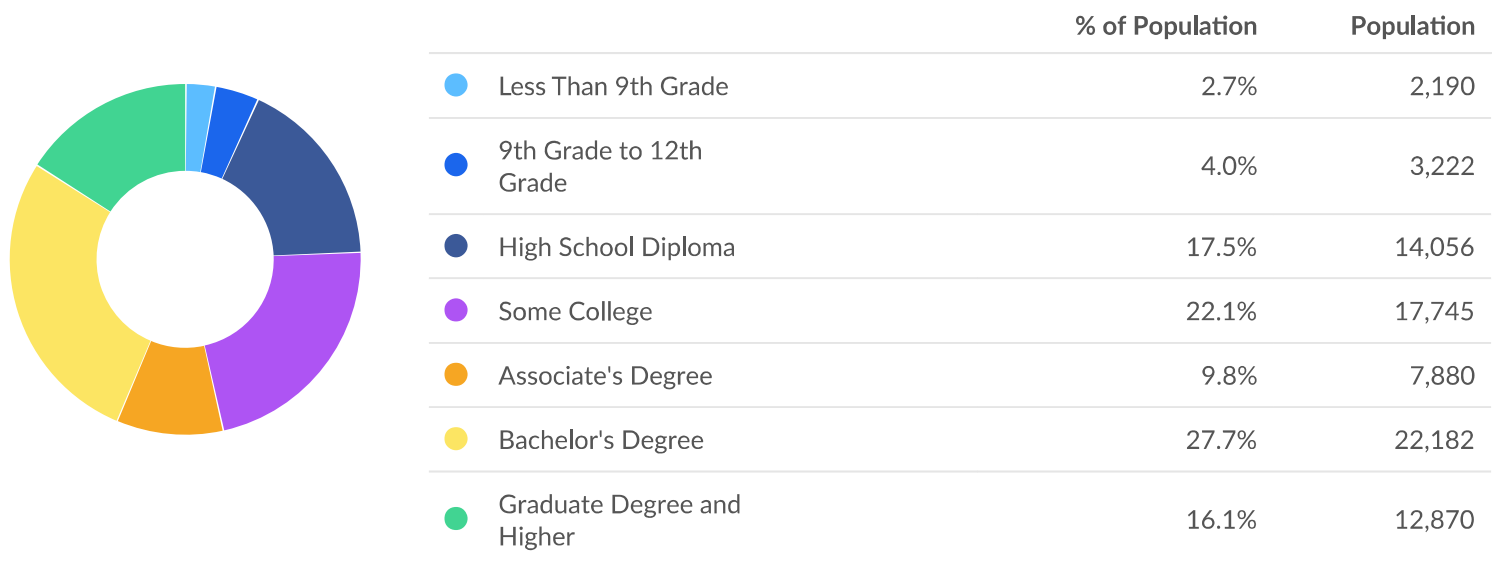

Apr 2023 Labor Force Breakdown



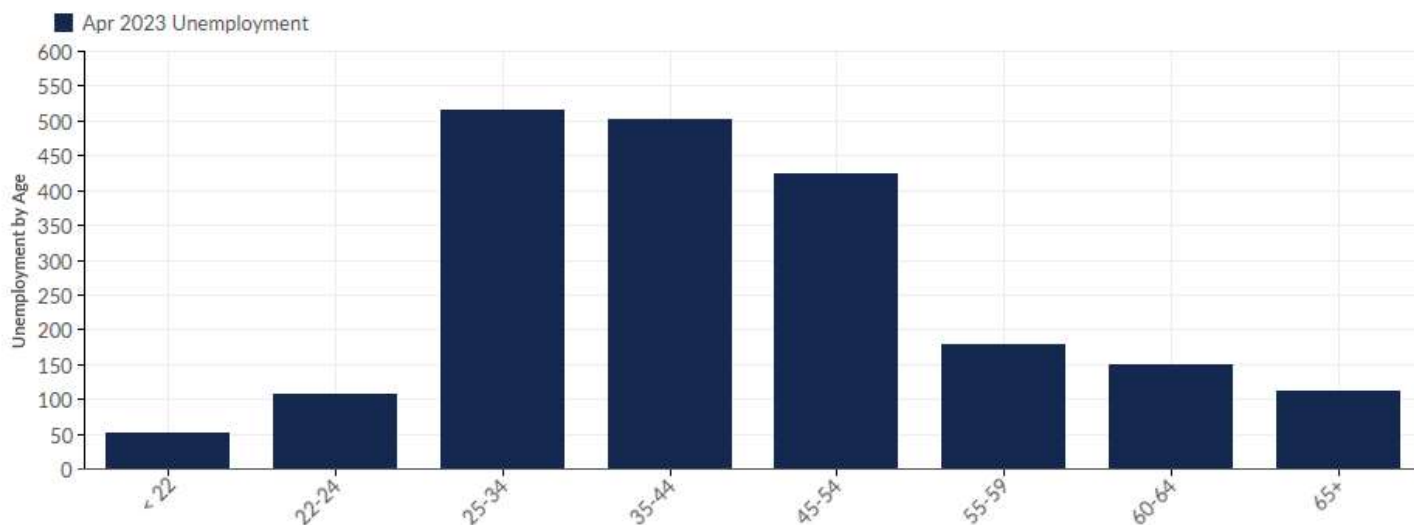
Educational Attainment

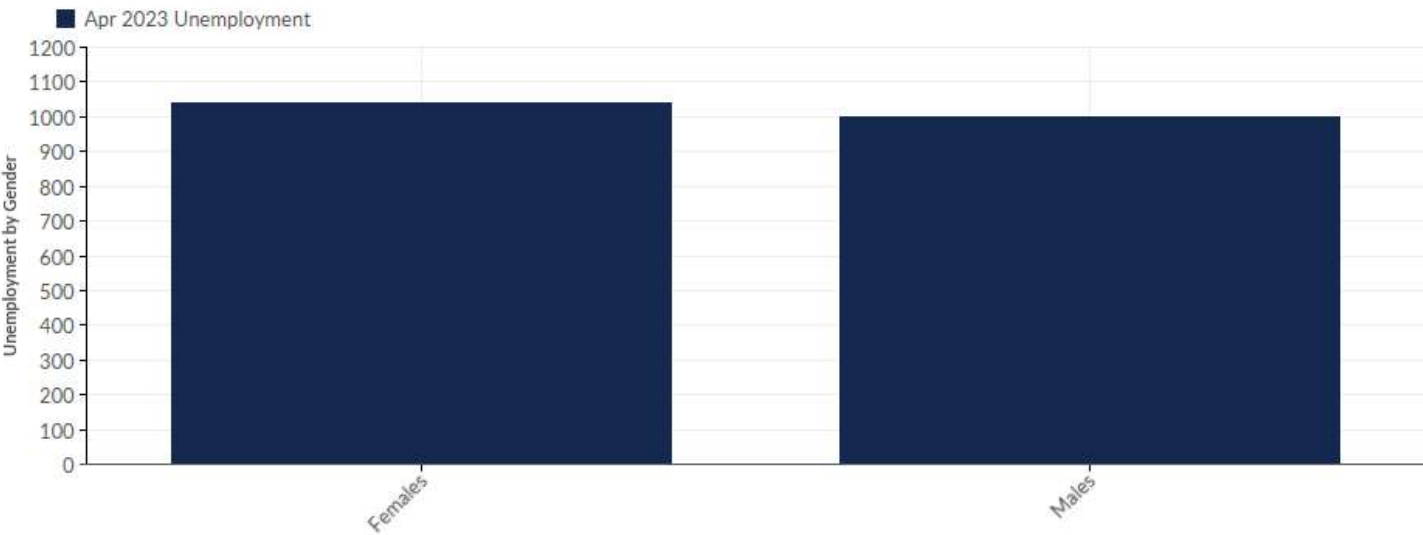

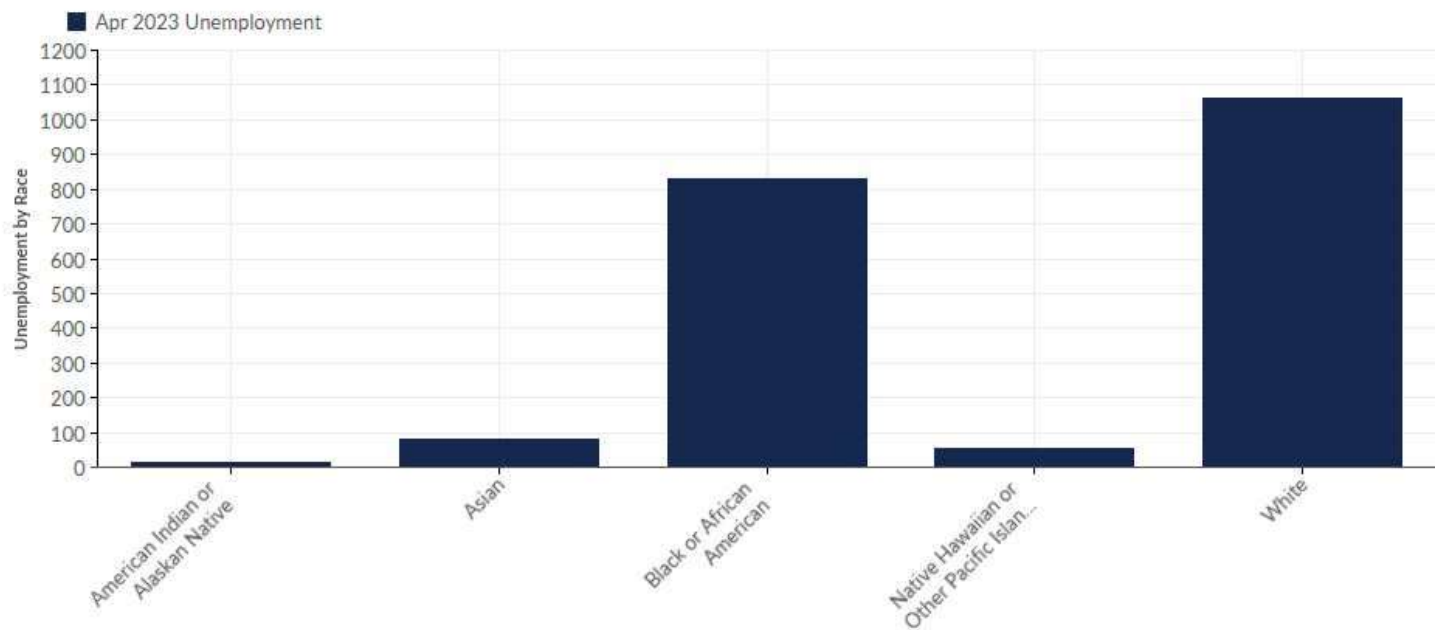

Unemployment by Gender



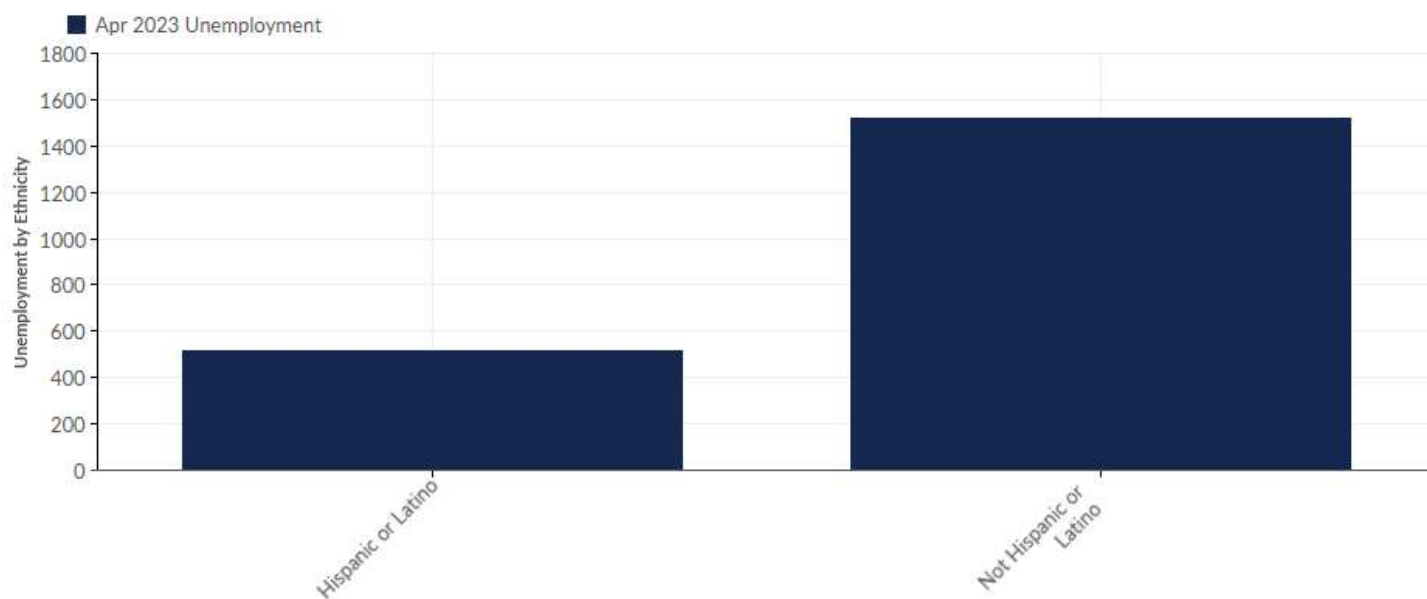

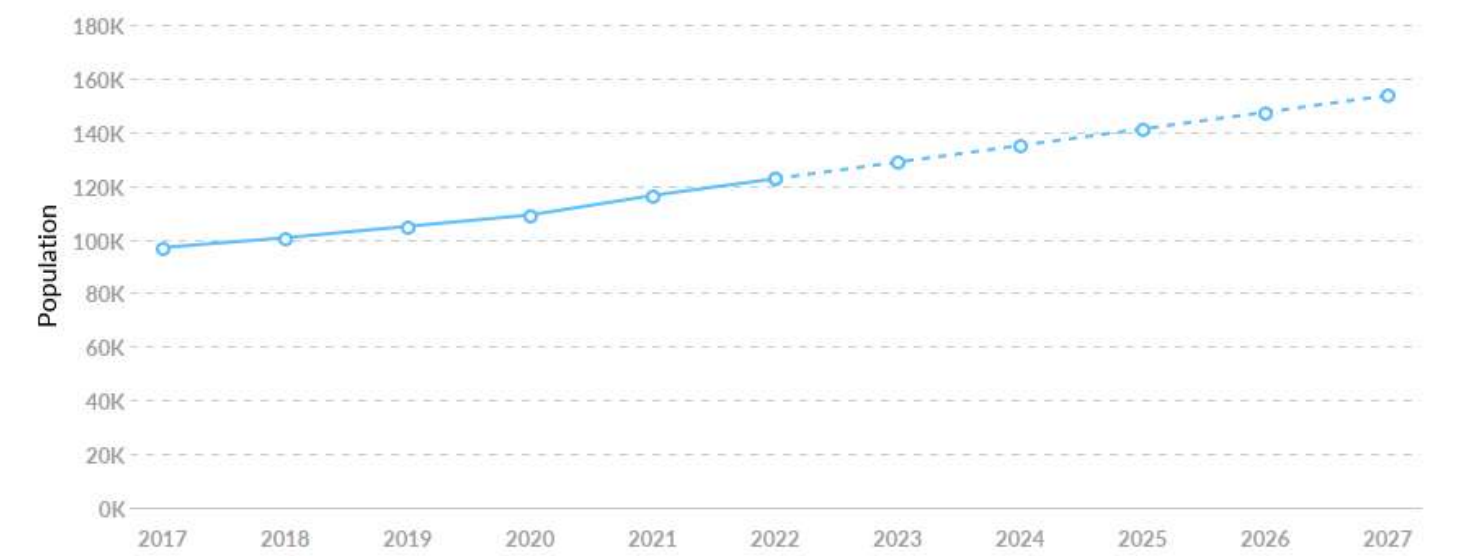

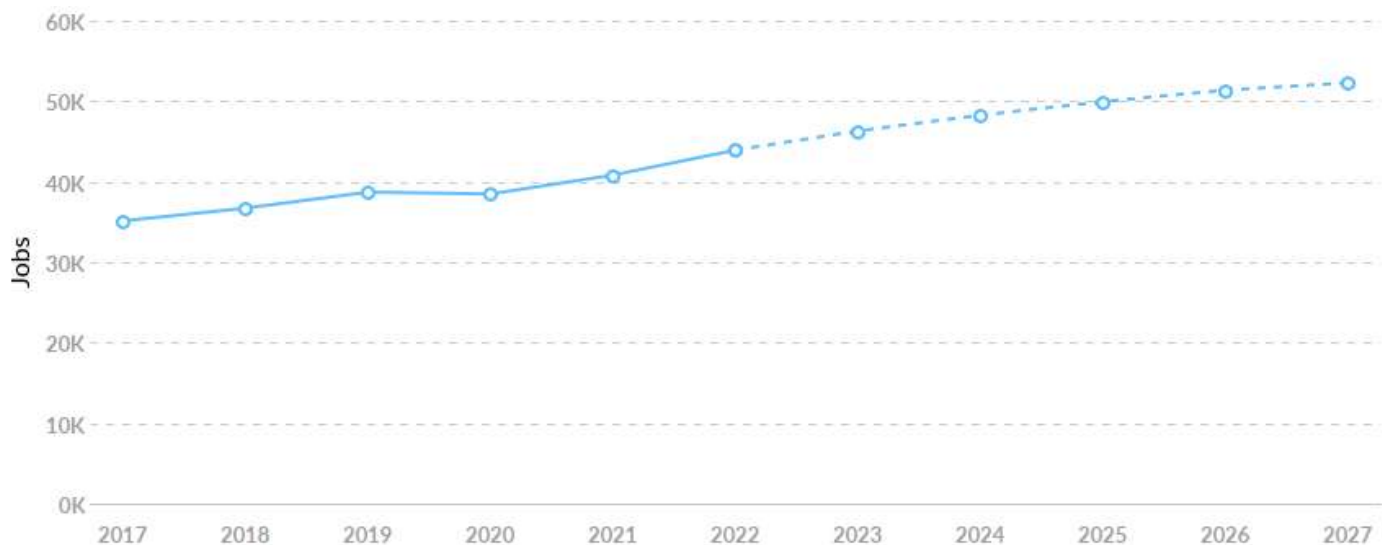

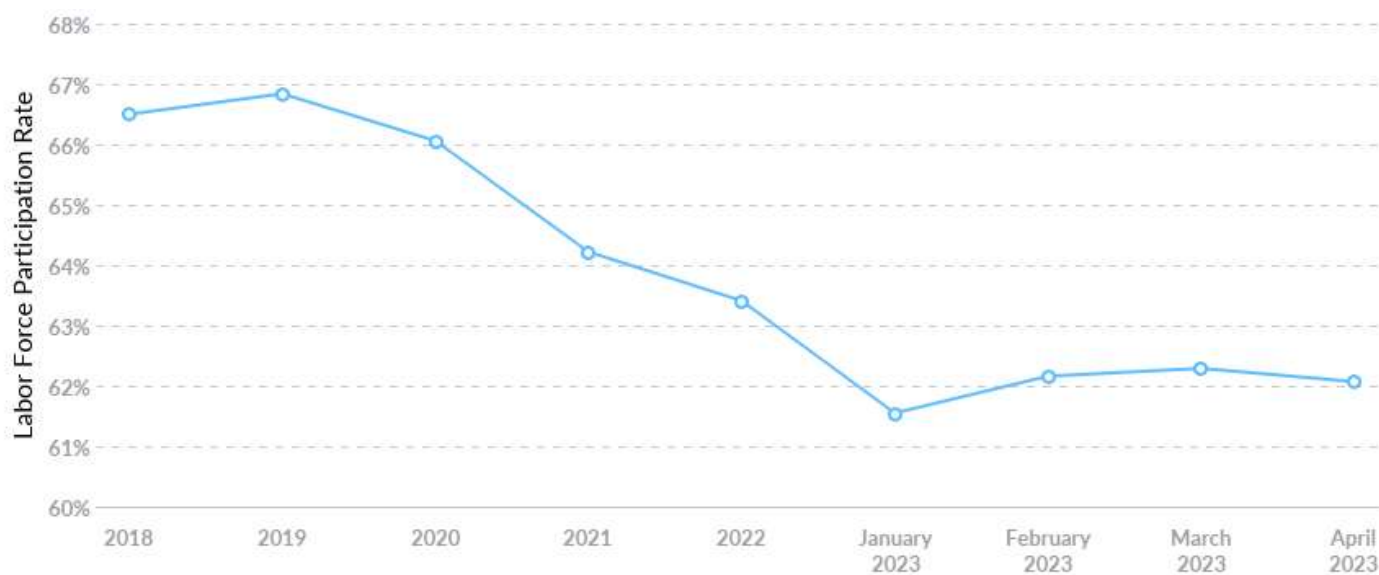
Job Trends

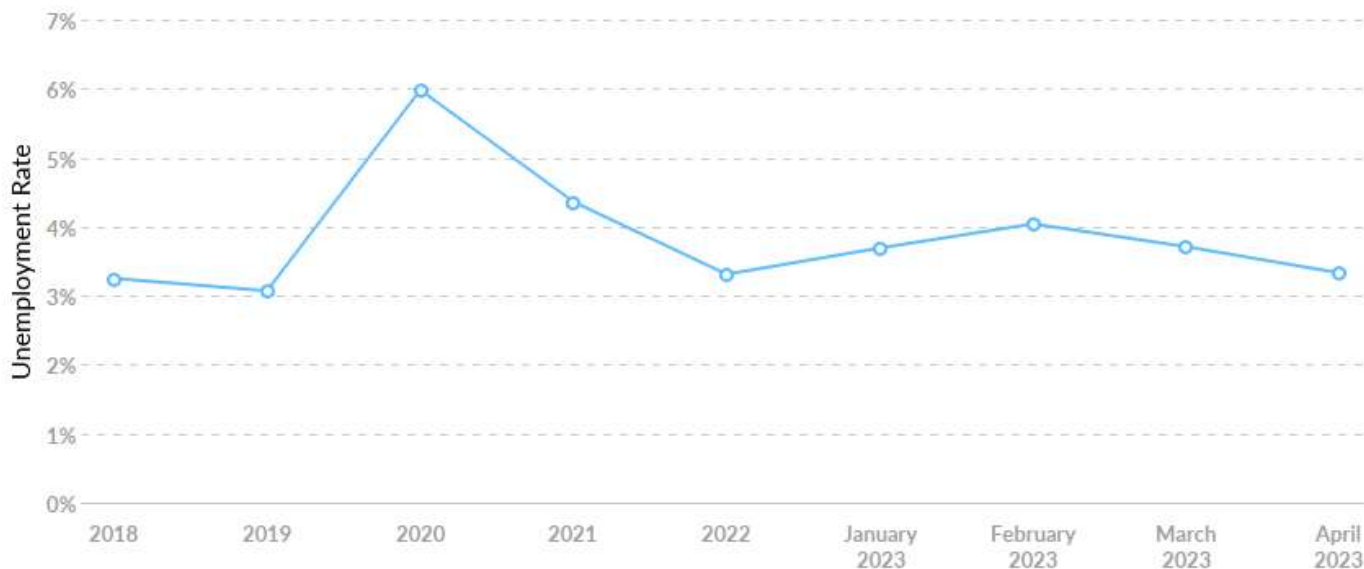

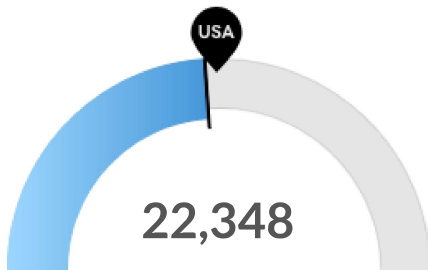
Unemployment Rate Trends

Rockwall County, TX had an April 2023 unemployment rate of 3.33%, **increasing from 3.25%** 5 years before.



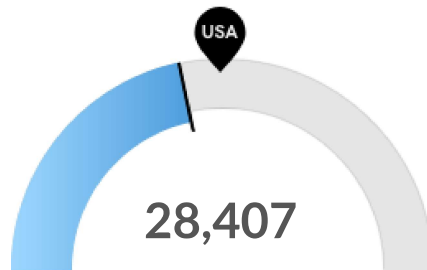

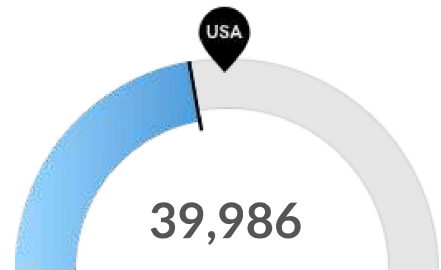
Millennials

Rockwall County, TX has 22,348 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 23,773.



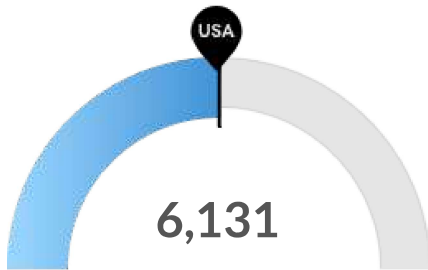
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is low in Rockwall County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 34,593 people 55 or older, while there are 28,407 here.



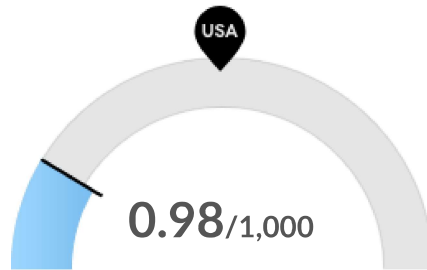
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Rockwall County, TX. The national average for an area this size is 47,360 racially diverse people, while there are 39,986 here.



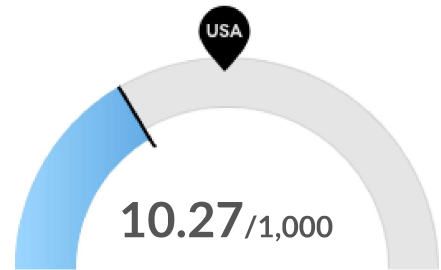
Veterans

Rockwall County, TX has 0.98 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.59 per 1,000 people.

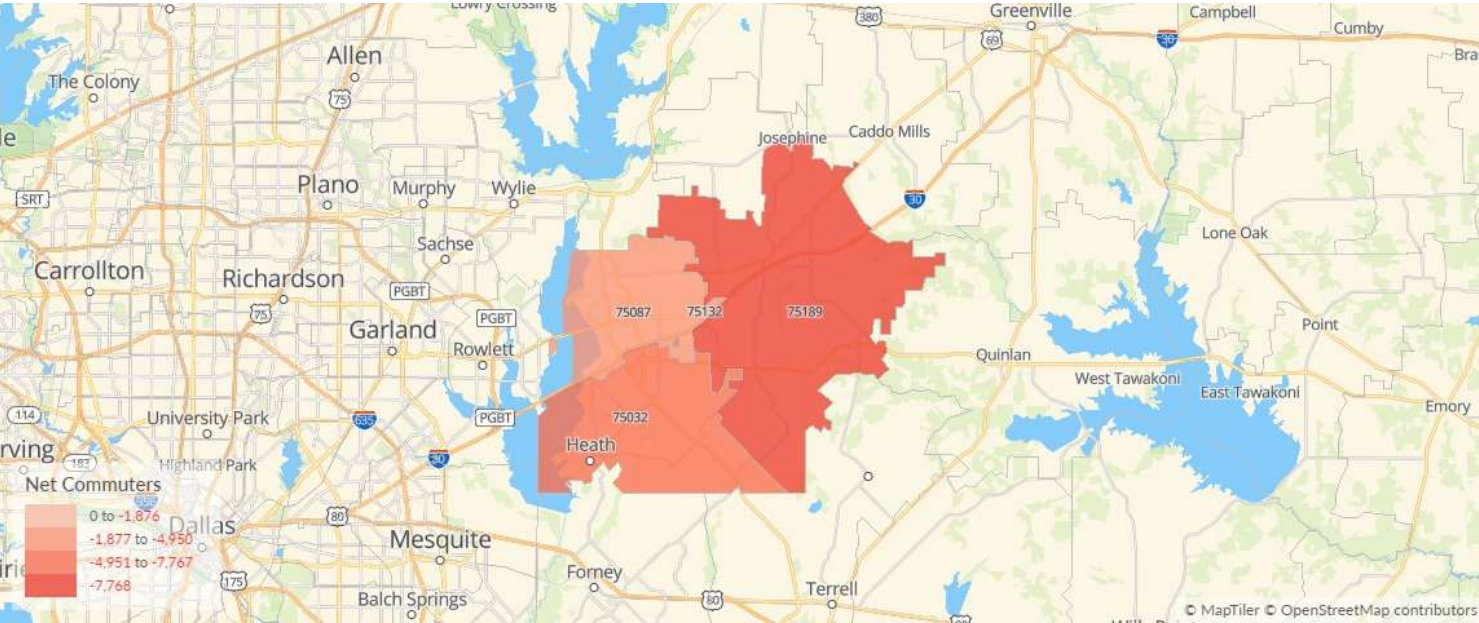


Property Crime

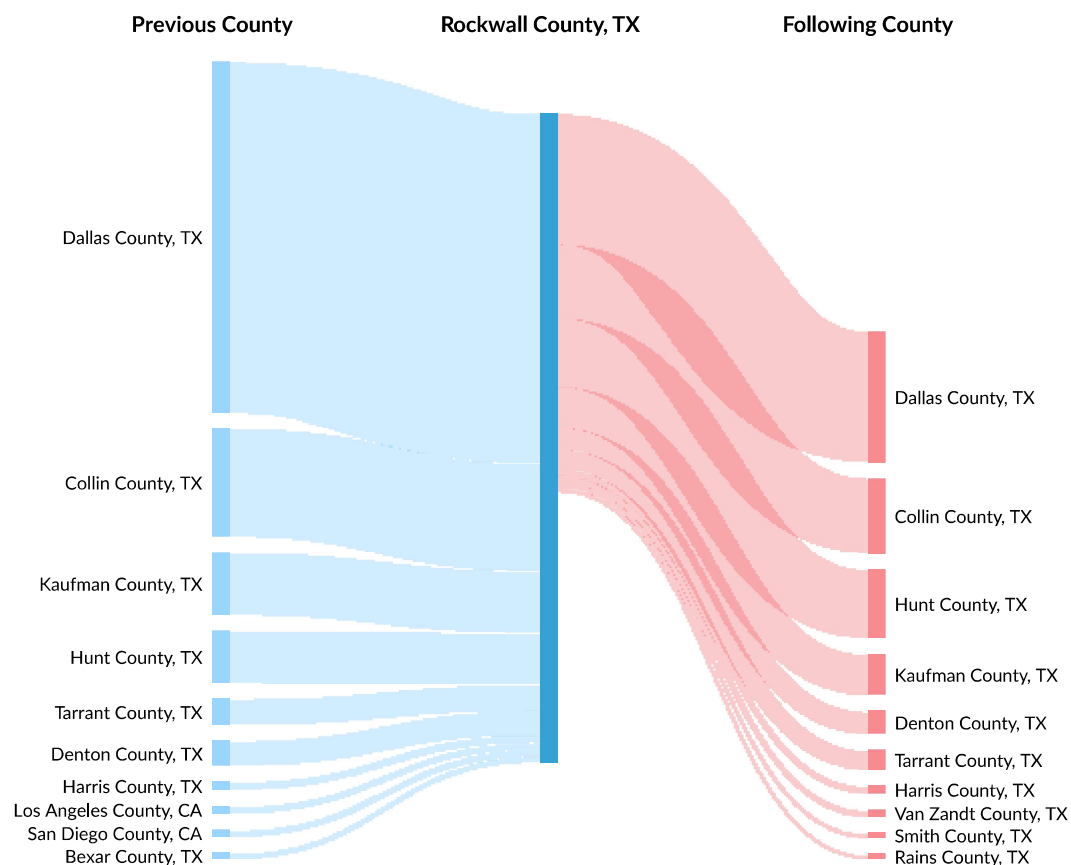

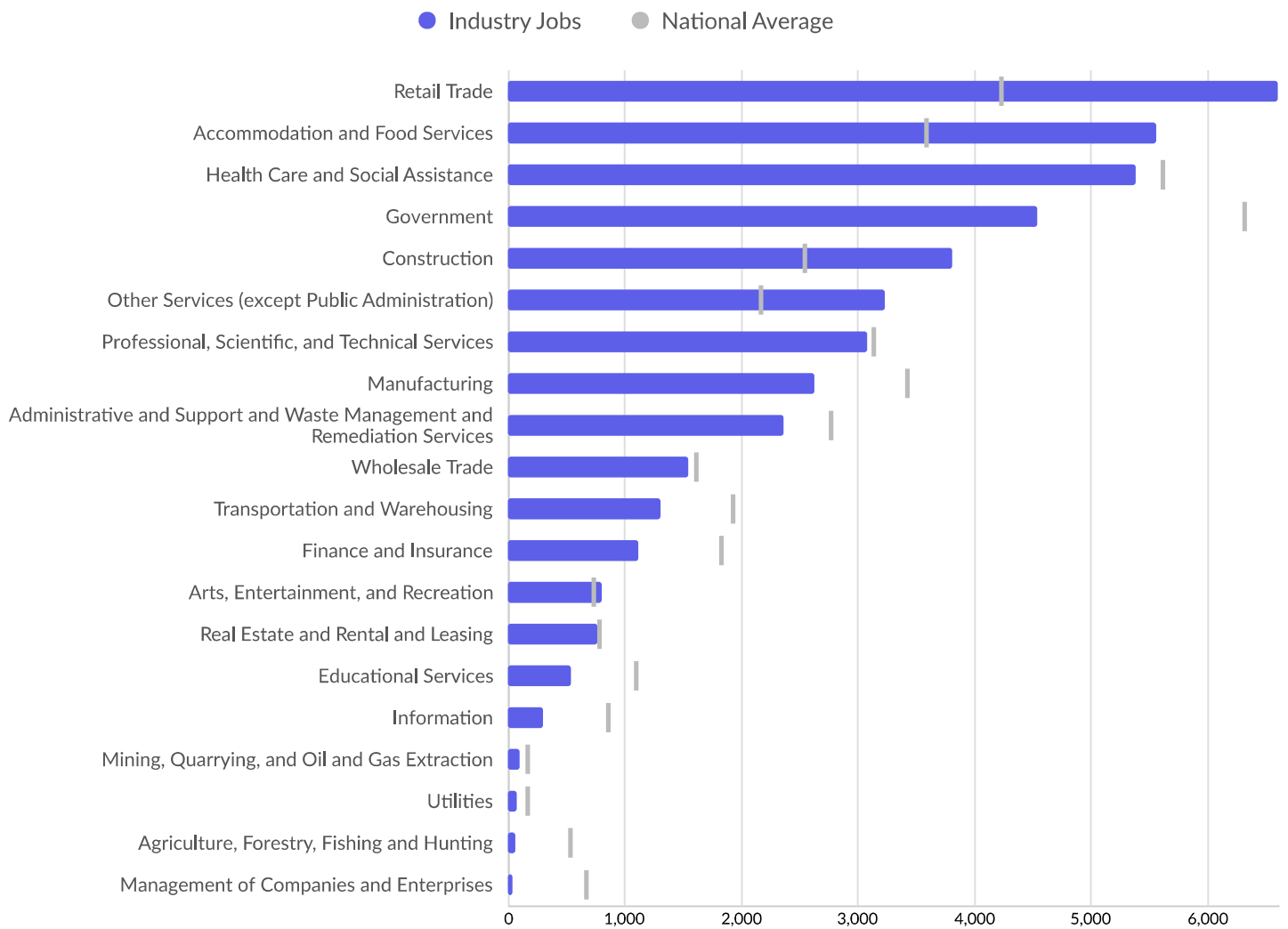

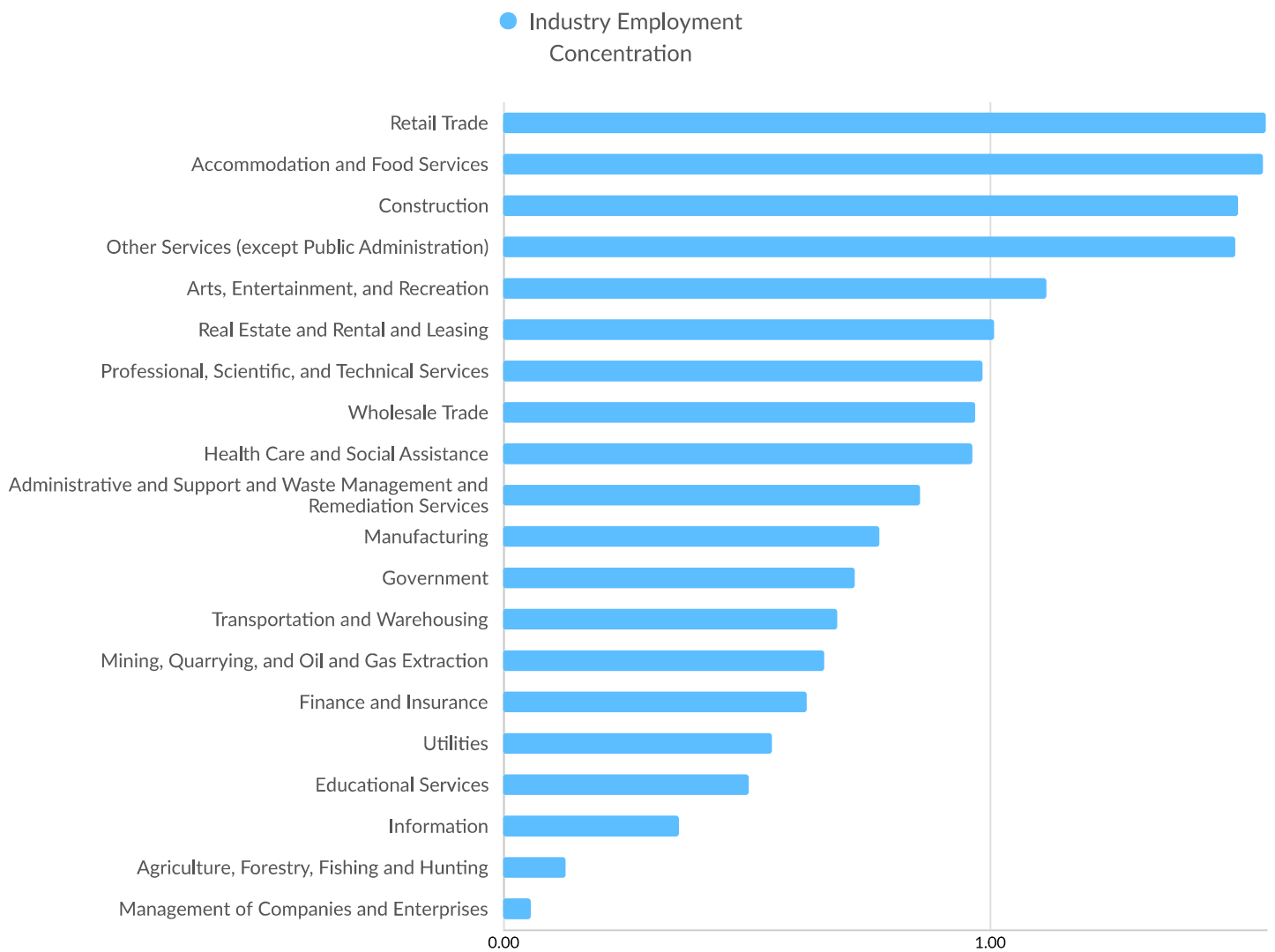

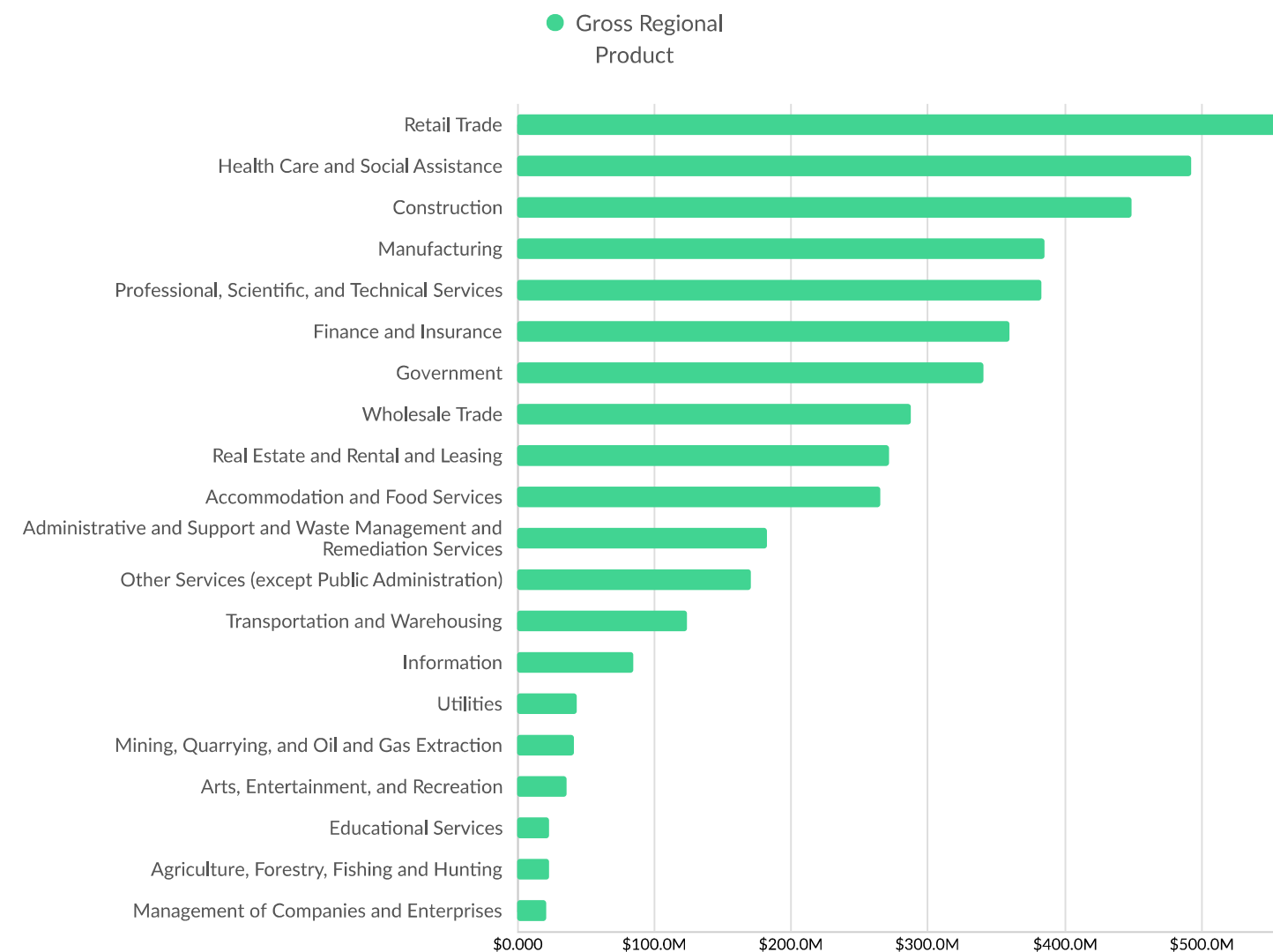
Top Growing Industries



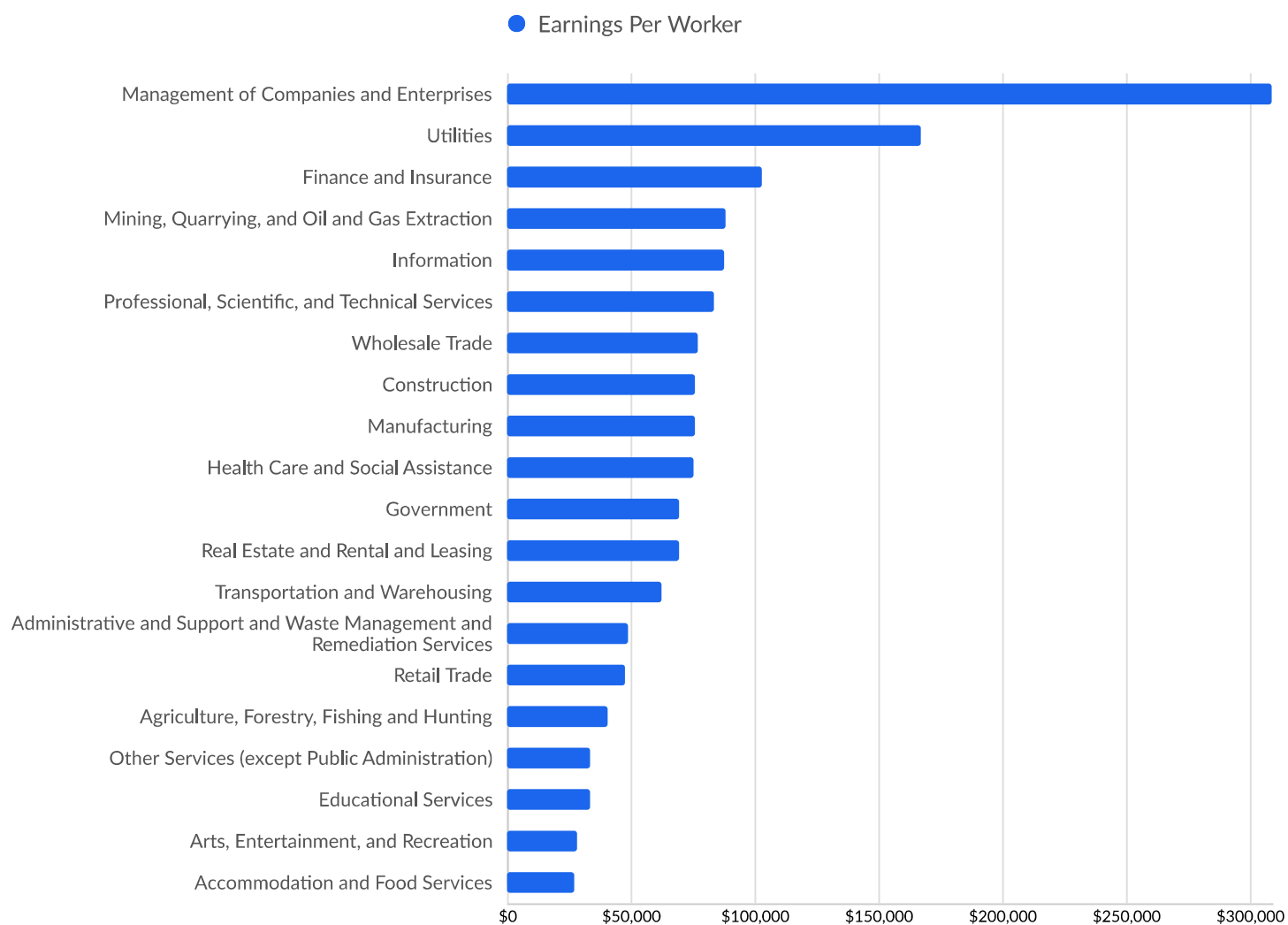
Top Industry Employment Concentration

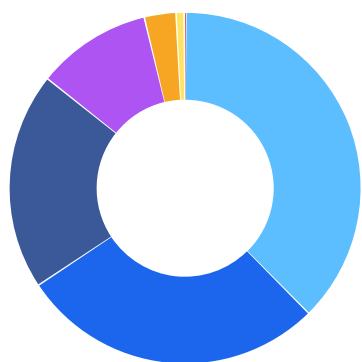

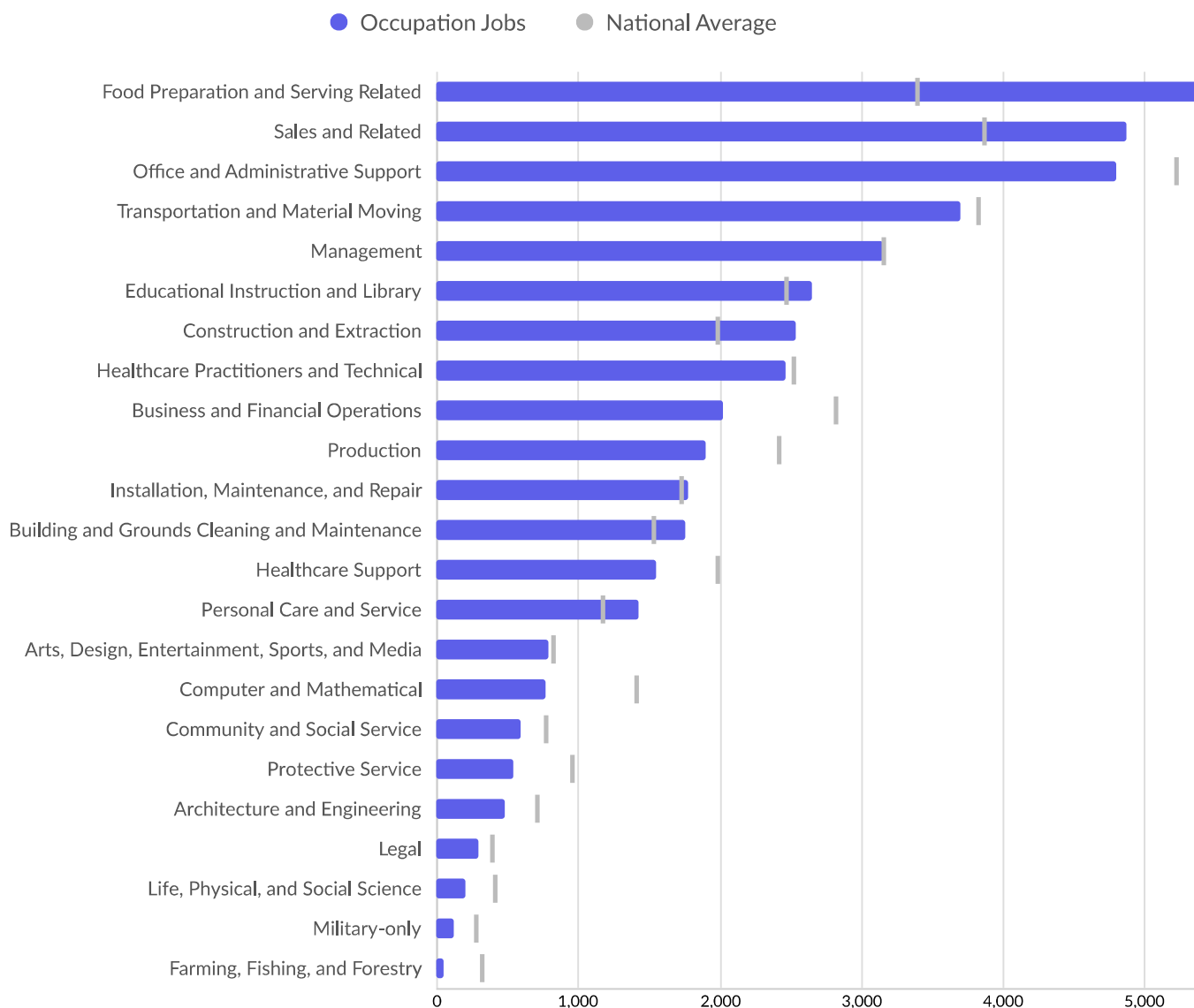

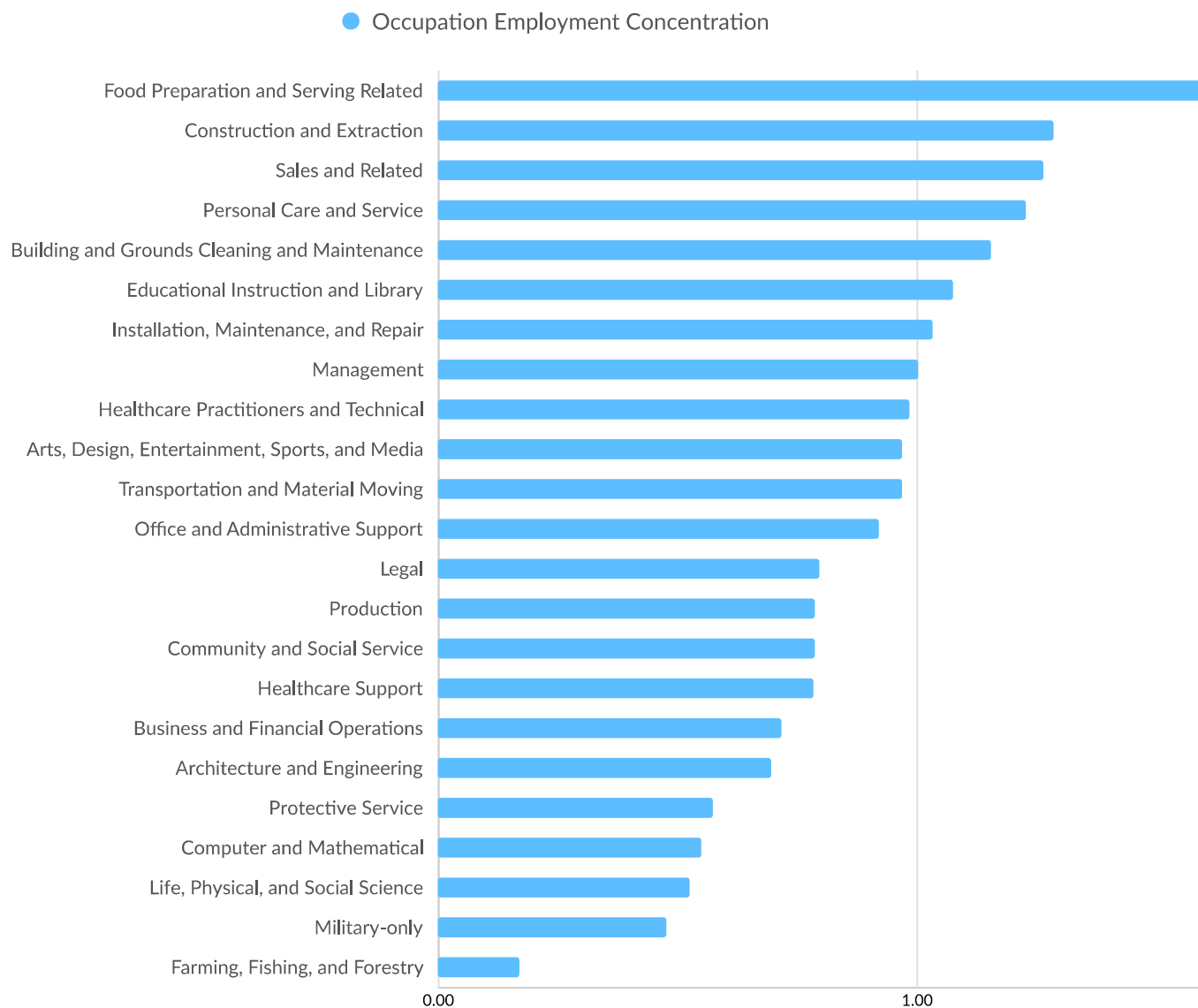

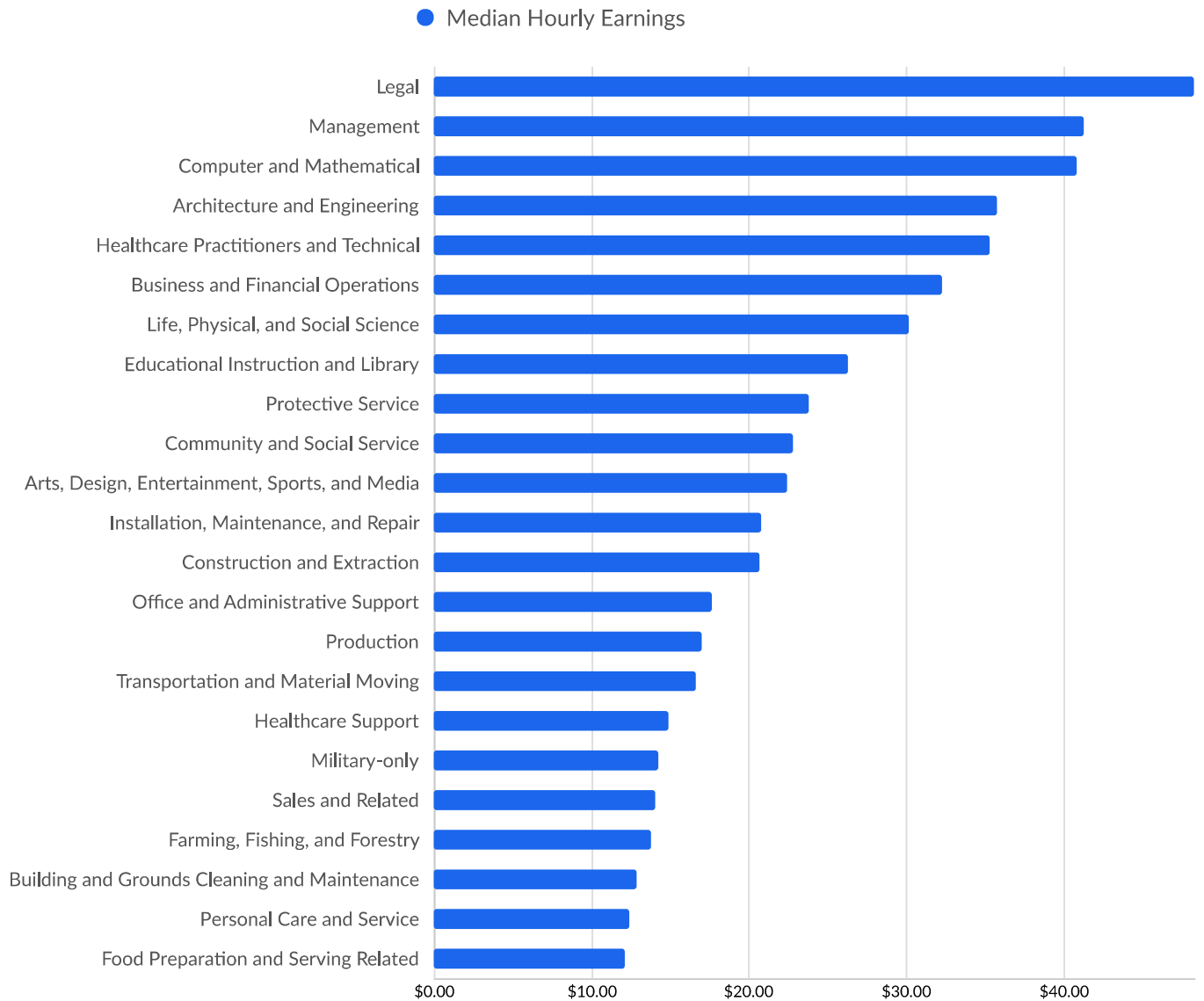
Top Growing Occupations



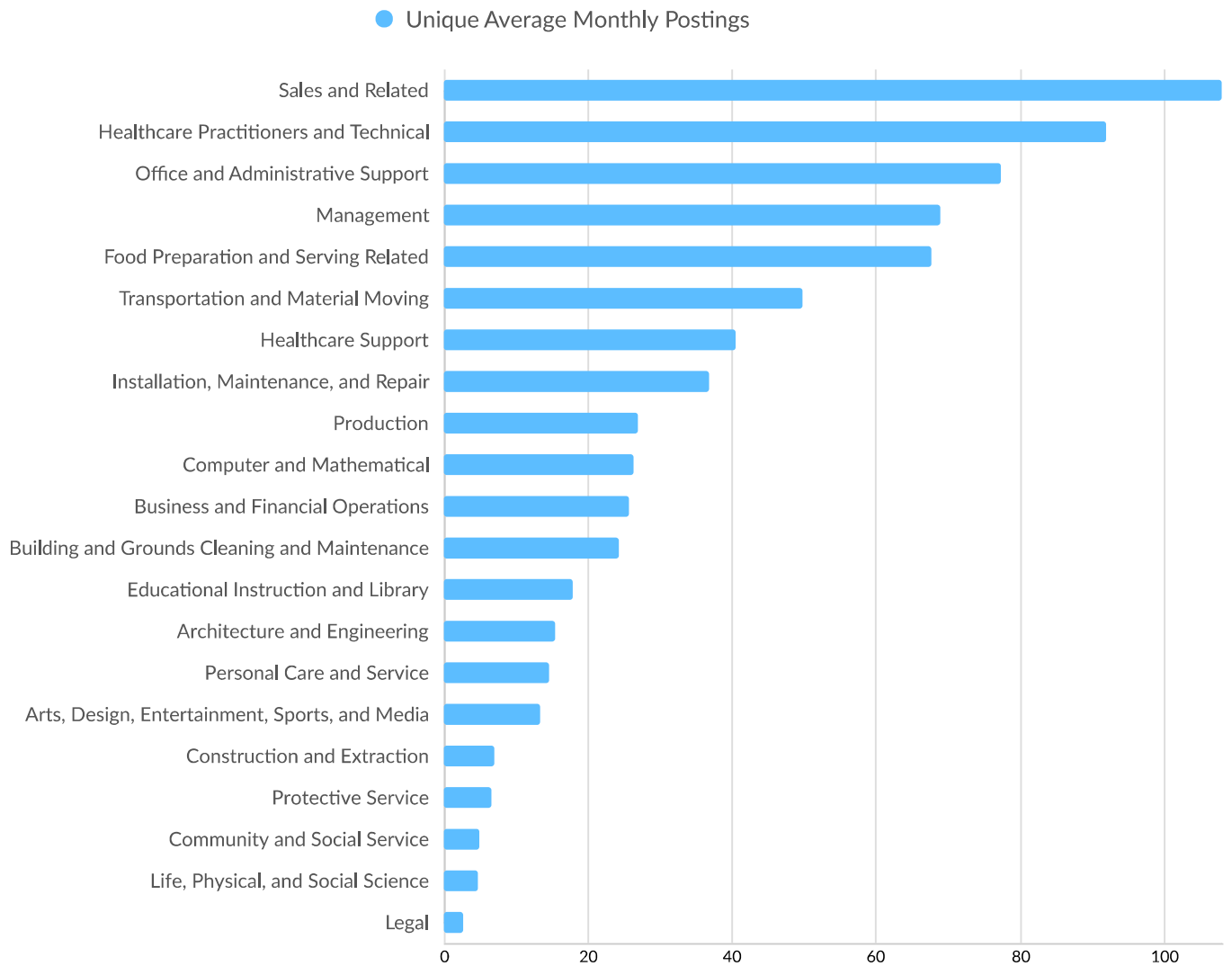
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



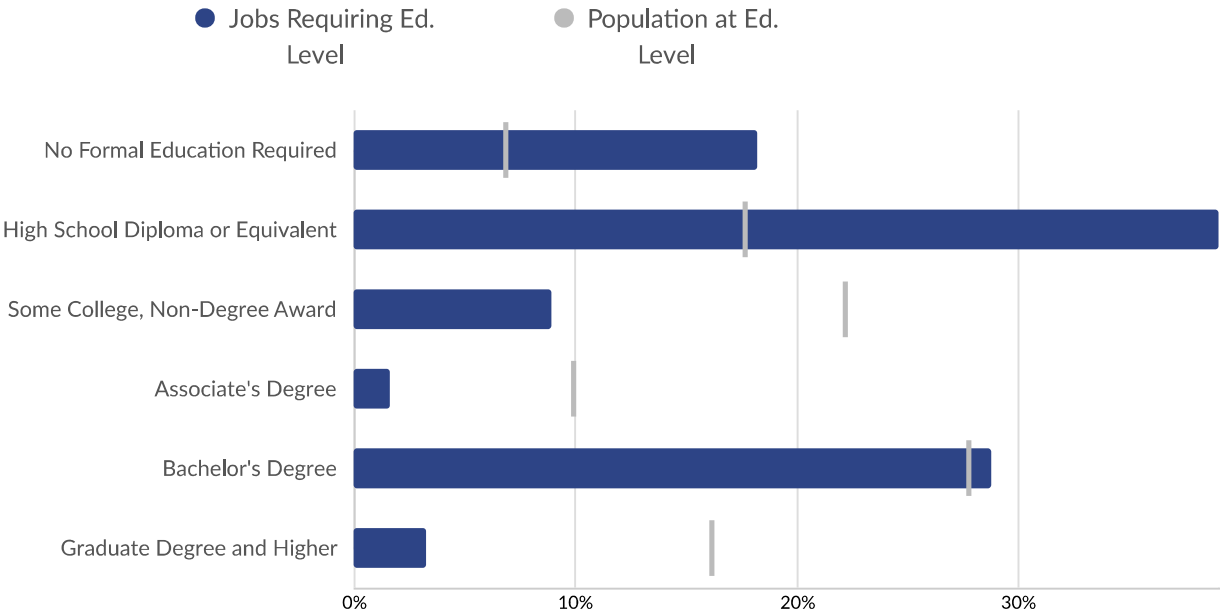
